#### **CLUB NEWS**

A Special General Meeting of members was held on Sept. 17 in Aldergrove with 10 members present. Show Chair Margaret Jones sent in a report about the initial plans for the 2015 Specialty to be held April 4, 2015 in conjunction with the Renaissance Club. The Conformation judge will be Wyoma Clouss, a Min. Schnauzer breeder from Idaho, with Obedience to be judged by Karen Brearley. Margaret will be working with a Show Committee made up of herself, Karsten Kaemling, Anita Norman, Bruce Fraser, Kristal Kenna and Erin Moore. She is also working with Sheila Ehmann and the Skaha Kennel Club for judges for the 2016 Specialty.

A set of by-law revisions prepared by Bruce Fraser and previously distributed to members was approved. The most significant change was to insert the Life Membership category, which had been overlooked in the previous constitution update. The specific wording is: For members completing twenty five (25) consecutive years of membership and in recognition of their contribution to terrier breeds and the society, those members will automatically be given the designation of "Life Members". Life Members will not be required to pay membership dues.

Larisa reported that the Club Website has been updated to include new members.

The Annual General Meeting will be held in late January.

#### **NEW CHAMPIONS & TITLEHOLDERS**

Erin Moore reports that **Am/Can Ch. Castanewf's Paint The Town Red** (a.k.a. Parker) finished both his Canadian and American Championships owner-handled by Erin Moore with limited showing. He completed his Canadian Championship at 8 months of age, winning 3 BPIG's. In July 2014, Parker finished his American Championship at the Terrier Association of Oregon Specialty under judge Patricia Nemirovsky de Alsina. Parker was awarded a total of 5 majors in limited US showing. He was awarded BB from the classes several times and won a Group 3<sup>rd</sup> from the classes at the Tacoma Kennel Club under judge Paula Hartinger. July saw Allyn Power's blue Lakeland girls from Threlfall travelling to Colorado in their new wheels (motorhome) for a fun weekend of barn hunt and earthdog in Colorado. DD earned her Certificate of Gameness from the American Working Terrier Association and is now **Ch. Threlfall Tantoo Cardinal CG JE** (pictured). Her daughter Purple (**Threlfall Diamond Tooth Gertie JE**) earned the first leg of her AKC junior earthdog title. Both girls qualified in Barn Hunt Instinct AND both earned the first leg towards their RAT Novice title.



Heather and David Lindberg's new puppies scored an impressive debut on the Vancouver Island circuit in August. The male, **MacBrechin's Machair Ryder**, finished his Championship in just four shows. Ryder made his show debut in Courtenay where he won Winner's Dog, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and Best Puppy in Group. The second day he again did well with Winner's Dog, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Best Puppy in Group. Ryder's third show was in Victoria and he earned another Best Puppy in Group. He followed that immediately with a Best Puppy In Show under breeder judge Jim Reynolds. On his fourth day in the show ring, Ryder got his Canadian championship with a Best of Winners win. His litter sister, Cricket, did well picking up points on her first days in the ring too.



Barry Truax is proud to announce the 32<sup>nd</sup> new Glenfraser homebred Champion, namely **Glenfraser's Blackwatch Piper**, aka "Bentley", who finished at 10 months. This typey black boy has proved to be a "natural" in the ring, gaining his first point at 6 months and showing consistently over the summer. He is sired by Ch. Glenfraser's Single Malt 2<sup>nd</sup> and his dam is Ch. Glenfraser's Piper Rose, and is co-owned by Barry with Steve Mardyn, brother-in-law to his co-breeder Darlene Lenfesty.



Margaret Jones is proud to say that "Spirit", aka Kian's First Lady O'The Isles, obtained her Championship after wins in Glacier View and Vic City. She was Best of Breed 3 of the 4 days and also gained a Group 4 as well as going Best Puppy in Show at Vic City. She is bred and co-owned by Margaret with Jeff and Charlotte Thompson. Her sire is Am Ch. Terriwood's MVP (tied for #1 Cairn in the US 2013) and her dam is Ch. Kian's Breezydays O'The Isles.



#### **SHOW WINS**

This has been a very good summer for Janis Trotzuk and her Specials Scottie. At the Kamloops shows, **GCh. Trotters Man In Black**, earned 3 group placements in a four-day period, awarded to him by judges Mr. Windsor (Group 3), Mr. Oates (Group 2) and Mr. Kostopoulos (Group 2). Then with so few shows in the local area, aka Cole, again with his handler Cynthia Seeling, went off to the Skaha shows in Osoyoos, BC. The sun was shining down on Cole, where he again earned 2 group placements in three days. Judge Michael Doherty (pictured) gave Cole a Group 3<sup>rd</sup> placement and judge Wayne Thompson also recognized his qualities and gave him a Group 4<sup>th</sup> placement. That week's wins earned Cole a standing in the Top Five of dogs in Group Four who earned the highest number of points in a week, according to the *Canuck Dogs* and published in the *Canadian Dog Fanciers* e-magazine summary. [Editor's note: Cole is currently ranked #3 nationally in the breed.] Cole loves to be out and about at the dog shows and is always happy to share the news with the girls at home.



Pacific K.C. held its popular 4-day show at Hazlemere July 24-27 with a large number of associated Specialties. The first day was a good one for Soft-Coated Wheatens, with John & Penny Rogers' Special, **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, winning the Group with Best Puppy going to Judy Hodgkins' **Hion Monkey Business** under Carmen Haller. Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **GCh. Darwyn's Special Blend**, went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Haller and the next day won the group under Johan Becerra-Hernandez, with Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **Ch. Trotters Man in Black**, going Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, going Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. Donna Conod also gave the Group to the Welsh, and Group 4<sup>th</sup> to the Wheaten.

#### **Terrier Puppies on the Island Circuit**

The 9-day Vancouver Island circuit in August (comprising the Campbell River, Glacier View and Vic City shows) has always been popular, both for venues and weather. However, it has probably never seen such keen Terrier **puppy** competition as this year. A total of **five** different terrier puppies ended up winning group placements and Best Puppy in Show over the course of the circuit! American Staffordshire puppy Michl R Man Of Steel won the Terrier Group and Best Puppy under Doreen Marsh and went on to BPIS under her the next day, plus Group 4<sup>th</sup> and Best Puppy under Bill Walkey. Amstaff breeder judge Karen Doyle preferred the Kerry Blue Terrier puppy, Kingael Bluecrush Queens Crown, owned by former club member Barb Ward (the only owner handled puppy in the winners list). She won Group 1<sup>st</sup>, and went on to BPIS under Lynda Saranchuk. Then at Glacier View in Courtenay, Heather and David

Lindberg brought out their new Scottie pups, and the male, **MacBrechin's Machair Ryder**, took Best of Breed over Specials his first time in the ring, and went on to Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and Best Puppy under Sue-Ellen Rempel, repeating this impressive feat the next day under Marilyn Mincey, with a Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Best Puppy. At Vic City, James Frederiksen gave Margaret Jones' Cairn puppy, **Kian's First Lady O'The Isles**, Group 4<sup>th</sup>, and took her on to BPIS. The second day, Alvin Krause gave Best Puppy in Group to **MacBrechin's Machair Ryder**, and Jim Reynolds took him on to BPIS. The last day, it was the turn of Linda Carmichael's Westie puppy, Windacre Tiffen Is The Word, to take Puppy Group under Reynolds and go on to BPIS under Krause. So, a total of five different terrier BPIS in just nine shows! And then at Kamloops, no terrier puppies were entered – go figure!

Although the puppies stole the limelight on the Island circuit, other club members also picked up group placements. Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **GCh. Darwyn's Special Blend**, went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Marsh, and Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Walkey. Jackie Marriot's Scottie, **Dunsmuir's Black Ice Devil**, went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Doyle. Larisa's Welsh, **Darwyn's Secret Formula**, went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Rempel. Heather and David Lindberg's female Special, **Ch. MacBrechin's Evening Skye**, co-owned with Kim & Mike Salkus, went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under both Frederiksen and Krause. Reynolds gave Group 4<sup>th</sup> to Anita Norman's Kerry Blue, **Melbee's Tango Nuevo**.

At the West Kootenay K.C. shows Aug. 15-17, Joy Viel's Irish, **Ch. Red Branch D'Artagnan Of The Ring**, took Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Margaret Jones and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Ainslie Mills, all owner handled. As reported in the last newsletter, Joy won the terrier group in Vernon, and now we have the photo of that win.



At the four-day Kamloops shows, Aug. 29-Sept. 1, Doug Windsor placed Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, Ch. Trotters Man in Black, Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. Jon Cole and Seamus Oates awarded the Group to Anita Norman's Kerry Blue, Melbee's Tango Nuevo, with the Scottie going Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under both Oates and George Kostopoulos.

The Skaha K.C. shows were held again in Osoyoos at the shady Nk 'Mip campgrounds Sept. 5-7. Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **GCh. Darwyn's Special Blend**, went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Julio Ronco, and Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Martin Doherty who placed Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **Ch. Trotters Man in Black**, Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. The last day, Wayne Thompson placed the Scottie Group 4<sup>th</sup>. The club attracted a lot of puppies with its "Peach of a Puppy" tournament in the evening, preceded by a "Pup Squeak" tournament for "baby" puppies (3-6 mo.) which attracted 32 entries. The Peach of a Puppy event attracted 38 entries, so many that the advertised judges, Joy & Stewart Gladstone, had to be supplemented by two others. Unfortunately there was only one terrier entry, Barry Truax's Scottie, **Glenfraser's Blackwatch Piper**, who got Stewart Gladstone's second highest score, but when averaged with the extra judge's score, didn't place in the top four of the class. However, a good time was had by all, and the event was ultimately won by a Drever puppy.



The Mt Cheam shows in Chilliwack, Sept. 26-28, required two substitute judges for Terriers. Ann Hennigan filled in for Karsten Kaemling, and gave Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **Ch. Trotters Man in Black**, Group 4<sup>th</sup>. John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Yvonne Savard, and Leslie Rogers, filling in for Valerie Hansen, gave Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **GCh. Darwyn's Special Blend,** Group 2<sup>nd</sup>.
