The club's annual Specialty show was held the morning of **Saturday, June 18**, in conjunction with the Nanaimo K.C. shows held at Beban Park in Nanaimo. The noted terrier judge **Frances Smith** from Argentina judged all breeds and the Group. The Puppy & Sweeps judge was **Delvina Beaulac**. The Specialty was dedicated to the memory of Bob Malcom (1943-2021), husband of Sandi Malcom, Mimicker Miniature Schnauzers.

The show chair was Margaret Jones, the show superintendent was Ken Allen, and the show secretary was Classic Show Services whose webpage contains complete results: classicshowservices.ca. There were supported entries for Russell Terriers and Miniature Schnauzers offered by Ballymoon Kennels and Sandi Malcolm, respectively, and the Cairn Terrier Club of Canada sponsored a Booster. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Another Specialty has come and gone and all went smoothly and it was well attended! Our Show Chair, Marg Jones, was unable to be at the Specialty due to a judging assignment in Whitehorse but she did an amazing job of having EVERYTHING organized, ready, labelled and delivered prior to the start of judging so all I had to do was introduce our Sweeps Judge, Delvina Beaulac from Agassiz who stayed to ring steward for the show judge, Frances Smith Moffat of Argentina. Frances was very thorough and had lots of good comments about the quality of our terriers entered in the show! The weather could have been better – it rained off and on for the whole 4 days – but we soldiered on and the temperature was lovely and cool for the dogs! Ken Allen was our Show Superintendent and he seemed to be everywhere helping with everything including the booth knock down on Sunday for which I was extremely grateful! Sheila Ehmann had all the cheques organized and ready to be counter-signed so all our bills were paid immediately!

After the Specialty, we had an awards luncheon – John and Penny Rogers did a super job of providing the refreshments but as there was no concession on site, a lot of unexpected terrier exhibitors joined us and the food was ALL eaten except for a few veggies and dip! The good news is we have 5 NEW members and 1 rejoin as a result of the awards luncheon so it was well worth the extra bodies to feed. Barry did an excellent job on the trophies and certificates and several of the winners were at the event and able to get applause and congratulations for their excellent wins in 2020 and 2021.

I ran the club “booth” from Thursday noon until Sunday noon – I would suggest next year we only do Friday and Saturday at the Vernon show as there were minimal sales on the Thursday and the Sunday. I brought silent raffle sheets but so many people were asking to purchase items, I just made it a sale table with a basket raffle and a silent auction on Ilean Danby's Pet Portrait. We made \$577 in straight sales as well as tickets on 3 raffle baskets. There were no bids on the Pet Portrait – we weren't in a great location for foot traffic so we're going to try to offer the Pet Portrait via our FB page instead and see if there's any interest. I have a wonderful portrait from Ilean of my Welsh pony that captures his personality perfectly!

Caren Holtby ran a CGN test on the Saturday after Best in Show which had 4 people sign up and 2 passes for an additional income to the club – I believe we get half of the \$30 fee which makes it an additional \$60. Marg will do the financial summary for the show which will include these extra incomes.

As I don't work at the coast any longer (I'm now permanent part-time from home), I used this trip to the Island to accomplish a number of personal projects. On Friday afternoon, Sandi Malcolm took over the booth and I set off for Parksville to meet my cousin's daughters and their families and to spread my cousin Shelley's ashes in the Englishman River at Top Bridge and go for Chinese food in Shelley's honour. On my way back to the motel, I stopped in to see an old college chum at the Nanaimo hospital who has had a stroke and had a good visit with her with many laughs. The specialty is proposed for the Vernon show along with the Border Terrier Canada specialty and we would encourage other terrier breed regional or national specialties to be held there as well! SHOW REPORTS

The Renaissance K.C. held its annual set of four shows plus numerous Specialties on April 14-17 at Heritage Park in Chilliwack. About 50 Terriers were judged by Ben Wasylyshen, Tempest Deptuch, Michael Hill and Sandra Lex. On Thursday, Wasylyshen awarded Group 2nd to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Notorious**, who repeated the same win the next day under Deptuch who gave Best Puppy to the Norwich, **Ch. Paradym Amblegreen Double Take**, owned by Heather Tomlins, Cyndy Monk and Kelly Wood. Best Baby Puppy went to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Salient's Darwyn I Am The One**. On Saturday, Hill gave Group 3rd and Best Owner Handled to the Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Notorious**, and Baby Puppy again to the Welsh. On Sunday, Sandra Lex judged terriers, and made a similar call, Group 3rd and Best Owner Handled to the Welsh, Best Puppy to the Norwich and Best Baby Puppy to the Welsh – and took all three to the Best in Show level (Owner-handled, Best Puppy and Best Baby Puppy)!



A number of Terrier Specialties were held during the Renaissance weekend, including several for single breed, plus a full Terrier group with Terrier Breeders of Canada, and a Regional Scottish Terrier Specialty. In the single breed category, as judged by Sylvia Barkey, some club winners were:

Min. Schnauzers: Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **GChB. Empire Dreamaker Hot Tip** (Select Dog), and Ken & Elaine Allen's **Dreamaker Flaming Fury** (Best of Winners).

Soft-Coated Wheatens: Yan Zavelion's **Ch. Van Waren Check Me Out at Argona and Skyfall** (Best of Breed and Best Puppy)

Sealyham Terriers: Florenace Yunik's **GCh. Rocglen Money Talks Bushaway** (Best of Breed) and **Rocglen Ginger Heliabel** (Best of Opposite, Winners Bitch and Best Puppy)

At the Terrier Breeders Specialty, judged by Graham Kerr from Australia, the big winner, going Group 2nd in a field of 10 Scotties from all over Western Canada, was Heather Lindberg's **GCh. MacBrechin's Legacy Leidi**, coming out of retirement. Best Baby Puppy was Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Salient's Darwyn I Am The One**.



The Canadian Scottish Terrier Club, supported by its local members, sponsored a **Regional Specialty** in conjunction with the Renaissance Shows. Anne-Marie Arthur judged Juvenile Sweeps and the regular classes were judged by Dawne Deeley who has bred and shown Wire Fox Terriers. The show drew an entry of 12 with 5 in Sweeps, including top Scotties from Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Although all of the dogs had separate handlers, it was interesting to note that Ms. Deeley chose a litter sister and brother pair for her Best of Breed and Best of Opposite, and another brother and sister pair, sired by the Best of Opposite winner for the two Winners. In fact, all of the winning dogs were descended from Heather Lindberg's "Ryder" (**GCh. MacBrechin's Machair Ryder**).
