## TOP TERRIERS FOR 2011!

*Twelve Club Members' Dogs Rank Nationally*

In total, 12 dogs owned by club members (down from 14 the previous year) placed in the top 5 of their breeds in Canada last year, as recognized by *Dogs in Canada's* Top Dog point system. Another 8 dogs placed in the top 10 of their breeds, for a total of 20. This includes the breed leaders in Welsh and Norwich. The Welsh Terrier also placed #2 in the Terrier Group with 5690 points including 12 BIS, and probably for the first time in the club history, was ranked #10 All-Breeds!

## NEW CHAMPIONS & TITLEHOLDERS

Bruce Fraser reports that his Min. Schnauzer **Ch. Advocate's Just Jack CD** finished his companion dog title at the Golden Retriever trials in March. (He passed every trial he was entered in, was High in Trial at the BCATC Specialty at Tradex with scores of 193, 198 and 193).

Pearl Humenny reports that her Border Terrier **Ch. Benchmark's Winning Goal** ("Keeper"), finished his Canadian Championship in 2011 and his US championship in January, 2012. He was shown a total of 3 weekends in the States to accomplish this. To date in 2012, he has been awarded one Group first; one Group second, four Group Thirds, four Group Fourths, and a Group Second in the Saskatchewan Terrier Breeders show in Saskatoon in May. Joy Viel (Justnjoyits Irish Terriers) reports: "My girl, **Ch. Kenwood's Just NV Mee Cgn RE CDI**, not only finished her Rally Excellent title & her CDI (Novice Intermediate Scores 188, 192 & 193.5) titles we also managed to get one qualifying score towards her CDX. Not a great score (177.5) but it is a start. Those were our accomplishments for 2011 which meant we were the #2 Terrier in Canada in Rally (top 30 all breed). This year we are continuing to work on completing our CDX title and we need 4 more qualifying pairs (Rally Advanced & Rally Excellent in the same trial) to complete our RAE title in Rally. We need a total of 10 pairs to do this."

Bruce Fraser's veteran Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. OTCh. Advocate's Bentley RE**

completed his Rally Excellent Title at the Lower Mainland shows at the Tradex Oct. 29. "Bentley" is owned and bred by Gary & Bruce.



The same day, they also finished a New Champion, **Ch. Advocate Empire Over the Top**, owned by Bruce Fraser and co-bred with Vicki Stephens.

Heather and David Lindberg's homebred Scottie, **Ch. MacBrechin's Celtic Thunder**, finished his Championship at the Lower Mainland shows, handled by David Gignac. He is sired by Ch. Beinnein's Commander in Chief, ex Ch. Beinnein's Kenzie MacBrechin.

#### SHOW WINS

The 2012 show year in BC opened as usual with the Ladies K.C. shows in Cloverdale Jan. 27-29, and for the most part it included the same cast of characters as last year, the main differences being David Gignac's new male Westie owned by June Fraser, and Dianne Just bringing back her Norwich "Joe Cool", plus other youngsters. There were 14 breeds entered but only 3 had any class points available: 2 points for Cairns and Min. Schnauzers, and 1 point for Borders. That along with absentees and a handler dominated group ring meant the show was very competitive for very few Top Dog or Championship points. Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Am/Can GCh Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**, won the group under Carol Graham and the Swedish judge, Ms. A Ulltveit-Moe, and went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Jacqueline Rusby who surprised everyone by giving the group to a Dandie Dinmont. These judges chose different puppies as Best Puppy in Group, namely the Soft-Coated Wheaten, **Inverlochy's Barra**, owned by Trudie Forbes (under Rusby), a Westie puppy (under Graham) and a Border puppy, **Borderhouse Trans Ocean** owned by Rachel Adams.

At the Mt. Cheam shows in Chilliwack, Feb. 17-19, terrier breeder judge Dianne Ivey, gave Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and Best Puppy to Vicki Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Empire's Vanilla Bean**, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to Judy Gruzelier's Lakeland, **GCh. Waterwalk Retro Chic Cgn**. On Sunday, Katelon Bajona-Fox's Group 4<sup>th</sup> and Best Puppy went to Hollie Ben-Yosef's Min. Schnauzer, **Envoy Magic III Kara Mia**.

The following weekend, Lower Mainland Dog Fanciers held their “Spring Fling” shows at Cloverdale. Larisa Hotchin’s Welsh, **Am GCh & Can Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**, won the group under Mark Houston-MacMillan, and went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Guy Jeavons and Michelle Scott. Jeavons also gave Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to Judy Gruzelier’s Lakeland, **GCh. Waterwalk Retro Chic Cgn**. Another big winner was Ken and Elaine Allen’s Min. Schnauzer puppy, **Dreamaker It’s All Good**, who went Group 4<sup>th</sup> and Best Puppy, and then proceeded (twice) to Best Puppy in Show under Houston-MacMillan and Jeavons. And to round out the terrier Best Puppy in Show wins that weekend, we’ll let his new owner tell the story.

Joy Viel reports: “My great news this year is that I finally managed to find another Irish Terrier for my little family. **Red Branch D’artagnan of the Ring** (“Dart”) arrived at the LMDF show in Cloverdale at the end of February with his breeders from California. We officially did the paper work to make him mine on the Saturday night and on the Sunday he gave me a huge thrill by going Group 4 and Best Puppy in Show. What a start! I still can’t believe it. We are working on becoming a team and he is a silly juvenile boy but fun to watch. He just turned 1 year old on [April 30](#) and is even nicer than I hoped.”



The only shows in March were a set of small ones held for the first time by the Victoria City K.C. March 2-4, and again, Ken and Elaine Allen’s Min. Schnauzer puppy, **Dreamaker It’s All Good**, did consistently well, taking Best Puppy in Group all 3 days, plus Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Sandy Gelinias and Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Patricia Taylor, and on to Best Puppy in Show under Gelinias.

In contrast, the Renaissance Dog Assoc. 4-day Easter weekend shows, April 6-9, are rapidly becoming the second largest in BC (after Tradex), drawing dogs and handlers from all across the country. The terrier entries were around 62 dogs, and included a Specialty offered by the Terrier Breeders Assoc. of Canada, judged by Scottie breeder judge Vandra Huber, with Sweeps judged by her partner, Michael Krolewski on Friday.

At the Terrier Specialty, Larisa Hotchin’s Welsh, **Am GCh & Can Ch.**

**Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**, won the Group, with Group 4<sup>th</sup> going to Nancy Halford's Amstaff, **Ch. Marauders Ruger Vaquero**, and Best Puppy going to Ken and Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Dreamaker High Flyer**. Best Veteran in the Group went to Barry Truax and Nancy Day's 8-1/2 year old female Scottie, **Ch. Glenfraser's Peppermint Rose**, dam of 6 Champions, and still looking smart in a hard brindle coat and lively attitude. Complete results elsewhere in the newsletter.

The Welsh also won the Group under Edgar Bajona, plus Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Chris Neilson and Oscar Valverde-Calvo, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Bart Miller. Another big winner was Barry Truax's Scottie, **Ch. Glenfraser's Alexander Of Gallica**, who went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under both Neilson and Miller, with Valverde-Calvo giving Group 4<sup>th</sup> to Judy Gruzelier's Lakeland, **GCh. Waterwalk Retro Chic Cgn**.



A warm sunny weekend favoured the Tye K.C. shows May 11-13 in their new location, the Cowichan Exhibition Centre north of Duncan in the beautiful Cowichan Valley (relocated from their previous venue in Mill Bay). The well-lighted building housed 4 rings plus a wide variety of booths, and the club's ever popular lottery baskets, with free grooming sites pre-assigned in various barns and under the overhang of the buildings. A highlight of the show was the 1970s themed costume event on Saturday, with lots of exhibitors and handlers dressed up throughout the day. The final competition was quite hilarious - lots of tie-dye, outrageous colours, headbands, bell-bottom pant suits, huge hair, disco moves and so on. For once the handlers outshone their dogs!

The big winner was the appropriately named Min. Schnauzer, **Dreamaker High Flyer**, the puppy owned by Ken and Elaine Allen, who won the group under Thai judge Ekarat Sangkunakup and went on to Best Puppy in Show under Peter Machen, as well as Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Best Puppy under American terrier breeder judge Betty-Anne Stenmark, and Best Puppy in Group under Machen, all handled by Brian Kruse. In fact 8 different dogs shared the dozen group placements, including a different group winner each day (Westie, Aussie, Schnauzer). Also placing in the group was Judy Gruzelier's Lakeland, **GCh. Waterwalk Retro Chic** who went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsuir's Black Ice Treasure** who went 4<sup>th</sup> under Machen.

News at Darwyn Welsh Terrier (Larisa Hotchin): The first part of 2012 has been full of exciting things with Larisa and Michael Hotchin of Darwyn Welsh Terriers! First of all, Parker (**BIS/BISS Am/Can Ch. Darwyn's Webslinger**) has gone to Australia! Temporarily. Parker is in Sydney Australia, will be shown for a couple of years there (he's only 4 years old now) and we hope to take him back to Montgomery one day and show him as a veteran there so that people can see what the 2009 BOB winner there matured as! Parker's new co-owner has flown to Canada twice over the last year and participated in Joy Henderson's handling classes. She's not a breeder yet – but hopes to one day! But, for now she is very excited about showcasing Parker down-under!

The next exciting news from Darwyn is that Joe (**MBIS/MBISS GCh Am & Can Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**) broke the all-time Canadian record for BISs for the breed! Recently (during May), Joe was awarded his 93rd career Group 1st Win (6 of them in the US) and his 16th Best in Show! The Best in Show wins outside of BC during 2012 were awarded by Barbara Dempsey Alderman (Medicine Hat), Donna Cole (Hub City, SK), Cheryl Myers-Egerton (CKOC), Ed Wild (CKOC). Joe has also won 2 more Terrier Specialities this year! Joe is being shown by Milton Lopes out of Alberta.



Larisa started to get another young boy out to the show rings and so far went to two shows - Burns Lake and Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers. This young boy (Zorro) picked up 9 points at Burns Lake and then finished his championship by winning the group again at Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers in Victoria! Zorro is now known as **Ch. Darwyn Don Diego de la Vega**. Zorro is the son of two well-known "Darwyn" Welsh - his dam (who hasn't been shown in Canada yet) was Winners Bitch at Montgomery 2011 (Welsh Terrier Club of America Nat'l Specialty) and his sire, Monty, was Select Dog at the same National Specialty. Monty was shown in early 2011 by Larisa and won a few groups of his own! Zorro is being presented in the show rings with Aaron Andriash.

And - we have puppies! We are currently growing up a few "Joe x Dora" puppies that were born in the spring time. I'm liking what I am seeing in both temperament and conformation. Fun times ahead!

The Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers Assoc. shows this past weekend (May 24-27) at Saanichton, normally a small show, brought some new faces and a lot of handlers into the ring. As noted above, the first day under Richard Meen, Larisa Hotchin's yearling Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn Don Diego de la Vega**, won the group and the next day placed Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Wendy Maisey, handled by Aaron Andriash. June Fraser from Calgary was in attendance with her new Westie import from New Zealand, NZ Ch. Whitebriar Jaw Dropper, handled by David Gignac. This is the first import from this famous kennel for many decades, and even as a yearling he is clearly outstanding. He placed 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> the first two days, then won the group under Grant Townsend and Michael Hill, and finished the weekend with a BIS under Hill.

Overall, the terrier groups were dominated by handlers (7 to be exact) competing for about a maximum of about 20 points, with few breeds offering class points. Other club winners were Hollie Ben-Yosef's Min. Schnauzer, **Envoy Foxy IV Cayenne**, going Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Meen, Ken & Elaine Allen's junior puppy, Min. Schnauzer **Dreamaker High Flyer**, going Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Best Puppy under Townsend, and Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice Treasure** who went 2<sup>nd</sup> under Hill. An Amstaff puppy handled by Dawne Deeley was Best Puppy the other 3 days, and picked up a Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.
