TOP TERRIERS FOR 2012!

Twelve Club Members' Dogs Rank Nationally

In total, 8 dogs owned by club members (down from 12 the previous year) placed in the top 5 of their breeds in Canada last year, as recognized by *Dogs in Canada's* Top Dog point system. Another 9 dogs placed in the top 10 of their breeds, for a total of 17. This includes the breed leaders in Irish, Schnauzers and Welsh. The Welsh Terrier also placed #2 in the Terrier Group with 5440 points including 16 BIS, and for the second year in a row, was ranked #7 All-Breeds, up from the #10 spot last year! In addition, Krystal Mason's Min. Schnauzer ranked #1 Mini and #5 Terrier with 77 Group placements and over 1300 points, all owner handled!

He received two WD at the set of shows in Sacramento [April 11 - 14](#) and the final two points to finish. Now he gets to have fun and grow up a bit before he heads back into the ring. I screwed up on the other (he passed all the exercises until the very last, long down, when I flicked my wrist as I left and he followed me out!)."



Bruce Fraser reports that **Can/Am Ch. Advocate Empire Over The Top** ("Kylie"), co-bred with Vicki Stephens & owned, conditioned and handled by Bruce, finished her American Ch. in Idaho with Cathy McMillan, taking two five point majors followed by two more as a Special. Owner Bruce Fraser took the leash at Great Western in California where they attained another 5 point Select and finally a BOS in a total entry of 55 at the National Specialty, leaving Kylie needing only another 5 points for her Am. Grand Championship. Back at home, Kylie was Virginia Lynne's Group 1st choice at Vernon Kennel Club. She was awarded Group 2nd the other two days (see photo on page 7).

Debbie Miyashita reports that **Fernrigg's Over the Moon** (Ronnie) is now Champion, winning Best of Breed over 3 other Borders at the VDKC show last weekend in Lavington under terrier breeder judge (and club member) Don Emslie. "We are truly "over the moon" with this puppy - the nicest one I've bred in 15 years of playing this game and I think the one that has BISS potential! Still can barely fit my swelled head through the door! Thanks to Chelsea Raine for showing her for me, thanks to Darren Pettit and Ilean Danby for also helping show my band of 4 merry Borders at the Vernon show. Everyone went for their eye checks on the [Friday](#) too and all passed with flying colours - always a huge relief!"



SHOW WINS

Junior handler Cassidy Furlong finished 2012 as top Junior in her breed (Dandie Dinmonts) in the U.S. In Canada she competed 21 times in Junior Handling and placed 18 times winning Best Junior 4 times. In the Breed ring Cassidy won 7 BOB and 4 BOS with her **dog Ch. King's Mtn. Alice Springs** and a Best Brace in Show with Simon Sez and Margie. She qualified for the Zone Finals for 2012. In the U.S. Cassidy competed in Junior Handling 25 times and placed 18 times. Cassidy received the top Junior award from the DDTCA for #1 Junior in her Breed and #6 Junior for Terrier Group. She won two International Best in Shows, three Group placements and was awarded an International Title.



Allyn Power reports that 'Purple' (**Threlfall Diamond Tooth Gertie**) finally met some judges who don't mind a Lakeland of another colour. She got three Group placements at the appropriately named Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club under Marilyn Mincey (G3), Charles Cyopik (G4) and David Eadie (G4). Even more exciting is her hunting prowess, as she dispatched her first gopher the day after we got home from the shows. She will be trying for her Junior Earthdog title at the next den trials.



Sunday, [May 19/13](#), **Can/Am Ch. Benchmark's Winning Goal** (Keeper) was awarded Best In Show by judge David Swartwood at the Regina Kennel and Obedience Club show. Keeper, bred and owned by Ron and Pearl Humenny, is shown by Eileen O'Neill and Cindy Kowalchuk-Corrigan. And the Canada Day weekend was also a memorable one as judge Allan Pepper awarded Keeper Best In Show on [July 1st](#) at Portage K.C. This topped his Group First that he received on [Saturday](#) from Judge Chris Neilson.



At the Vic City shows, March 1-3, Lyn Norman gave Group 1st to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey "Derek"** (who went on to Reserve BIS) under Ole Nielsen. Derek is currently the #2 Scottie in Canada according to Canuckdogs.



At the Tye K.C. show, May 10-12, Katelon Bajona-Fox, Rosemary Shoreman and Brent Wright judged terriers. Anita Norman's Kerry Blue Terrier, **Saredon Shock Waves of Irisblu**, took Group 2nd under all three judges. John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice** went Group 4th under Wright, and Joanne Helm's Irish Terrier, **Ch. Takala's Kelly Green**, went Group 4th under Bajona-Fox. Results from the Club's Terrier Specialty held that weekend are listed elsewhere in this newsletter.

At the Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers shows, May 23-26, Hal Pybus, Denise Cornelssen, Larry Kereluke and Sue-Ellen Rempel judged terriers. Joanne Helm's Irish Terrier, **Ch. Takala's Kelly Green**, went Group 2nd under Cornelssen (and is currently ranked #2 Irish in Canada) to finish her Championship, and Jackie Marriott's Scottie male, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**, went Group 3rd plus Group 4th under Kereluke. The Airedale Terrier Club of Canada held a Specialty, with club members Larisa Hotchin judging Sweeps, and Margaret Jones the Specialty classes.

Heather Tomlins reports that Amblegreen's news is all from down South as this year we have been focusing on US shows mainly. Cyndy Monk and I attended the Northern California Terrier Association shows in April along with the Sacramento Kennel Club shows. These were the first US shows for my young girls which was fun. The first two days were both a Specialty and a Supported entry for my breed with 41 Norwich entered. On the 2nd day **Am. Ch. Amblegreen Tutti Frutti** ("Tutti") went BOS in Sweeps and Winners bitch for a 4 point major. The 3rd day was a breeder judge and Tutti once again went WB for another 4 point major and also Best of Winners. We spent the week touring through Reno on our way to the Lewiston Idaho Spring Cluster. We once again had a great turnout of Norwich with 14 entered. There were 10 bitches present and Tutti went Winners Bitch/BOS the first two days to finish with two 5-point majors all from Bred By. We are so Proud of this young bitch finishing in one trip down. She is working on her Grand Championship now and is well underway.



In May we attended the Mount Baker KC show with 5 Norwich entered. Our 8-month bitch **Amblegreen Zigzag Mystic Mojo** (Macy, co-owned with Joan Herstein) went Winners Bitch the first day and Breed the 2nd day. In June we did the Blackfoot/Pocatello Idaho shows where 21 Norwich were entered. The first two days saw Peter Green and Beth Sweigart judging. Tutti's Littermate 'Taffi' (**Amblegreen Raffi Taffi**) went WB and BOW the first day and WB the second day for two five point majors to finish. Taffi is co-owned with Lynne Davis who showed her to the first 5 points. These are the first two US Champion kids for Am/Can Ch. Amblegreen Top Notch x GRCh/MBPIS Can Ch Amblegreen Bikini Blonde. On the third day young Macy went WB for a 5 point major too. She had gone Reserve to her older half Sister the first two days.

At the Comox Valley K.C. shows June 10-13, Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**, went Group 2nd under Lois Wilson with Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer **Empire's Private Dancer** going Group 4th. The next day, Frederick Dewsbury gave the Scottie Group 3rd, with 4th going to Ken & Elaine Allen's **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** who also went Group 3rd under Honey Glendinning. The last day Doreen Marsh gave the group to **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** and Group 2nd to **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**.

Nanaimo K.C. held a 4-day show June 13-16. Club member Bruce Fraser gave Group 2nd to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**, and Group 4th to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**, and Best Puppy to her **Darwyn's Santa Maria** who went on to BPIS under Butch MacDonald. The next day, MacDonald took the Welsh, **Darwyn's Santa Maria**, to Group 2nd and Best Puppy. Richard Paquette gave Group 2nd to the Scottie, Group 3rd to the Kerry Blue, **Saredon Shock Waves of Irisblu**, Group 4th to the Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**, and Best Puppy to the Welsh. The last day club member, Barbara Watt, gave Group 2nd to the Kerry and Best Puppy to the Welsh.

Despite the Club's booster, the Nicola Valley shows in Merritt June 29, 30 and July 1 only drew an entry of 12 terriers. The first day, club member Richard Lopaschuk gave Group 4th to Barry Truax's Scottie, **Ch. Glenfraser's Single Malt**. Terriers were also judged by Wayne Thompson and Sheila Verhulst. Debbie Miyashita organized a refreshment booth at ringside for the Club (despite delivering a litter one day), which was very much appreciated, given the heat. The club banner and brochures were displayed.

A larger entry around 30 dogs were entered at the Vernon shows the next weekend in Lavington. Virginia Lyne gave Group 1st to the Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Advocate Empire Over The Top**, co-bred by Vicki Stephens and Bruce Fraser, and Group 2nd to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**. The other two days, club members Tim Doxtater and Don Emslie gave Group 2nd to the Min. Schnauzer, with Emslie giving Group 3rd to the Scottie. Joy Viel made her first appearance with her two Irish Terriers as a Brace at the Vernon Kennel Club show. Comments of how "Brave" she was to attempt this with Irish Terriers just made her laugh!



News from Darwyn Welsh Terriers: Darwyn Welsh Terriers welcomes a healthy litter of 5 puppies born on July 1 – Canada Day! The sire is Joe (MBIS / MBISS Am. GCh./Can. Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That). The dam is Cola (a Parker daughter) - BPIS CH. Darwyn It's The Real Thing. This is the first time that I have done a mating where I can use Brackett's theory (let the sire of the sire be the grandsire of the dam) – fingers crossed for another BIS Welsh terrier in this litter! They have big paw prints to stand up to with this pedigree, but time will tell, let's hope lady luck is on our side.

And, I hope, there will be a wonderful Welsh Terrier litter born in Japan in the fall! In early July a long-time Welsh Terrier breeder (and licenced professional handler) stayed at our (Larisa and Michael Hotchin) home and brought a girl with him to breed to one of our very special dogs – a pretty girl with a lovely pedigree. The breeder is already making plans on showing one of these unborn puppies at Montgomery 2014! It was a wonderful week spent learning about terriers and showing terriers in Japan. I also learned some trimming tips from our guest (he apprenticed under Clay Coady 20 years ago). And, he has already made plans on coming back here in a few years time to breed another girl to one of my younger boys (Java - my new special!). A very exciting and special time indeed!

US Shows: Darwyn Welsh Terriers currently has 2 Welsh Terrier bitches being occasionally shown in the Eastern US currently, one that is owner-handled by the co-owner, and one handled by Ernesto Lara.

Tina - Darwyn's Tina Bossypants, handled by Ernesto, started her show career in late June in Virginia. On the weekend of the Virginia Terrier Club (and week before), Tina was WB 5 times (unfortunately while there were points, there were no majors). One of these wins was under a long-time Welsh terrier breeder judge.

Jessie - Darwyn Jesterr's Holding Court, owner handled by Jessie's co-owner Jane, was shown 6 weekends in May/June/July. During this time she picked up 14 points and 1 major (and 6 RWB to majors!!!! Darn!). Jessie was BOB twice over a specials bitch handled by a professional handler (and a Group 4th!), and defeated bitches for Winners or RWB over professional handlers ten times. Jessie's co-owner is not very well known and not very outgoing so these wins were particularly encouraging about judges being willing to put unknown owner-handlers over well-known professional handlers.

Australia: Parker – **MBIS Am/Can/Australian Ch. Darwyn's Webslinger** – continues to be occasionally shown by his co-owner, Sonya in Australia. So far this year, Parker and Sonya have won 1 Best in Show, 1 Runner-Up Best in Show (RBIS), 3 Group 1st and 2 Group 2nd (they don't have group 3 and 4 awards). Sonya isn't pushing hard with Parker in the show-ring, sees him now mostly as her house pet and one that she can go to the show ring with a couple of times a month. Parker is currently the #2 Welsh Terrier in Australia in all-breed points.

Canada: Darwyn Welsh Terriers in the last 2 years was very focussed on showing our top dog, Joe, and not showing others much so as to not take away focus from Joe. This year, Larisa is focussing on getting a few of our girls out into the show ring as well as showing our young (15 month old) exciting Specials boy. To do so, we are working with a few people to get the dogs into the ring, while Larisa is doing the majority of the work herself. Our young specials boy (Java – **Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**, a Joe son) is typically presented with Michelle Yeadon. In limited showing, he is currently the #1 Welsh Terrier in Canada, with a few group placements.

A few of our other girls are also being shown – Noodle (the import from Hungary), Dora (Java's dam and WB from Montgomery 2011), Ella (a 2 year old Dora daughter) and now a new puppy – Maria, who debuted at the Nanaimo shows (prepared and handled by Larisa – breeder/owner). Maria picked up 9 point towards her championship at the Nanaimo shows with 3 WB awards, 1 BOB over a special, Group 2nd (behind the Westie!), 4 BPIG awards and a Best Puppy in Show award! Maria will be shown at the upcoming AKC set of shows if you want to see her, but will not be shown very much until she is older. We at Darwyn are very excited about Maria, specifically since she has both of our two top dogs behind her (both Joe and Parker) and also our top bitch from the US – MBIS Sanherpinc Paisa. Time will tell, but we are very happy with what we are seeing with her (and the feedback from so many people at Nanaimo was overwhelming!). Thank you to everyone that stopped by and said Hi.
