CLUB 2010 AWARDS EVENT

On Saturday July 16, the club held its annual awards event at the lovely home of Barb & Fred Goddard. The club trophies were announced and handed out with attractive “keepers” for the winners (see page 2). Four new club Life Members were also announced and their biographies read (see page 3-6). In addition, certificates for top 5 and top 10 standings in their respective breeds were handed out (those not present will receive them in the mail). In total, 14 dogs owned by club members placed in the top 5 of their breeds in Canada last year, as recognized by *Dogs in Canada's* Top Dog point system. Another 5 dogs placed in the top 10 of their breeds, for a total of 19. This includes the breed leaders in Welsh, Wire Fox, Norfolk and Norwich. The Welsh Terrier also placed #8 in the Terrier Group with 984 points including a BIS.

NEW BCATC LIFE MEMBERS

The following are bio's submitted by our new Life Members:

Anita Norman

I can't remember a time when there wasn't a Kerry Blue in the Norman household. I am proud that through out the years my interest in showing and breeding dogs has become a family affair, with all three of my daughters actively participating in Ballymoon kennels. My girls and I have had a great time over the years travelling across North America to attend shows. My travels have included trips to England, Ireland and Thailand, where I have enjoyed meeting many interesting and knowledgeable people that I continue to remain friends with today.

In 1988 Ballymoons Flynn Tango was shown by David Gignac to #1 Terrier in Canada. Flynn sired 5 best in show winning Kerry Blue Terriers. The following year our Sealyham, also shown by David, went on to place #2 Terrier in Canada.

Being a BC All Terrier Club member has its rewards, like the support and "special" cheering section. During twenty-five years as a member of the BCATC I have held the position of Director and Vice President. I have enjoyed working with many different presidents, each with their own style and personality. Showing and breeding dogs has been a lifelong hobby. A hobby that has been rewarding, exciting and always changing. Who knows... maybe my greatest campaign is yet to come!

Don Emslie

Don came from a family that bred and exhibited English Springer Spaniels and during his early years he co-bred Labrador Retrievers with his father, exhibiting this breed in both conformation and field trials. Don became seriously interested in breeding Miniature Schnauzers in 1982 and with his breeding partner Tim Doxtater, has bred approximately 90 breeder/owner/handled Canadian Champions under the "Annfield" prefix, of which 45 have been shown to an American Kennel Club Championship title. In Canada, many of these are Best In Show winners and have ranked number one in the breed for a great number of years. Don has exhibited at and attended dog shows extensively throughout Canada and many states in the U.S.A. He has exhibited at Montgomery County Kennel Club Terrier Weekend for 19 years and has brought home a Winner or higher award, for 15 of these years from this prestigious weekend. A first for a Canadian Miniature Schnauzer was in 2000, when Don handled their homebred, Am/Can Ch. Annfield Oh For Sure to Best of Breed at the American Miniature Schnauzer Club National Specialty at Montgomery County weekend.

Don has attended the World Show in Amsterdam in 2002, the World Show in Mexico City in 2007, Crufts in England in 2003 and 2005 and the AKC Eukanuba Invitational, USA in 2006, 2008 & 2009 and won Best Of Breed there with Am/Can Ch. Annfield Turn Turn Turn. Don is a frequent attendee at the Westminster Kennel Club show in New York, where in 2002 he showed their owner/bred exhibit to Best Of Breed which set a record for a Canadian bred Miniature Schnauzer.

Don began judging in 1994 and is now CKC licensed for all breeds. He has had judging assignments in nine of the Canadian Provinces, as well as judging at some of the largest shows throughout the U.S.A. Judging assignments have taken him to Australia, Japan, Finland, Mexico, South Africa, Taiwan, Spain and the Philippines.

Tim Doxtater

Tim's first association with animals was with horses, owning and riding hunters. In his early days he owned purebred dogs of the following breeds: Rough Collie, Shetland Sheepdog, German Shepherd and Miniature Poodle. He became seriously interested in breeding Miniature Schnauzers in 1982 and together with his breeding partner, Don Emslie, has bred approximately 90 breeder/owner/handled Canadian Champions of which 45 have been shown to an American Kennel Club Championship Title. In Canada, many are Best In Show winners and have ranked number one in the breed for a great number of years.

Tim has traveled extensively to dog shows throughout Canada and many states in the U.S.A. and has attended the World Show in Amsterdam in 2002, the World Show in Mexico City in 2007, Crufts in England in 2003 & 2005 and the AKC Eukanuba Invitational in USA in 2006, 2008 & 2009. He is often seen at the Westminster Kennel Club shows observing judging and has bred and owned a dog that has won Best Of Breed at this World known event and which set a record for a Canadian bred Miniature Schnauzer. He has been a perennial exhibitor at the Montgomery Terrier Weekend in the USA and is breeder/owner of a dog that has been awarded Best Of Breed at the National Specialty at this prestigious weekend. Tim is an all breed CKC licensed judge and began this career in 1994. He has judged in seven of the Canadian Provinces, as well as numerous times in many states of the U.S.A. He has also judged in Australia, Finland, Japan, Mexico, South Africa, Taiwan, the Philippines and recently Spain.

Sheila Ehmann

As with the majority of dog club members, my life from an early age was influenced by dogs and life activities with dogs being an integral part. I don't believe my life experiences are really much different from anyone else in our sphere of dog activities. Perhaps a small difference is that I strongly believe in "giving back" to any Club in which I belong; not necessarily in monetary donation, rather 'in kind' which to me is volunteering in structured activities and mentoring and educating anyone interested in learning from me. Encouragement to others is probably the biggest legacy any of us can give to those who show interest in what makes us happiest.

Life with dogs started by my Dad bringing home a stray puppy when I was about 6 years old. He was white and was said to be a Westie but I have my doubts to his heritage. He was a great little dog who lived a Farley Mowat life with us. No fences, no kennel, perhaps a rope on the back porch to keep him at home when the dog catcher was around, but for the most part, Buttons led a charmed life roaming our (then) small town of Port Coquitlam. His life was ended at about age 7 due to chasing cars – not his first car he chased as we could never break the habit; rather it was the logging truck he didn't see after chasing the car. I learned at an early age how profound the death of a pet can be and how joyful the addition of another dog is. Bonnie was a large Sheltie who shared my life until I was married when a stroke took her.

In the mid-70's I purchased my first registered dog, a German Shepherd Dog. My first Canadian championship was with a GSD and I became a member of the CKC in 1983 and registered my kennel name of Damara. I bred two litters of this breed. In 1984 I purchased my first Westie from Sandy Davis of Lanarkstone Kennels after researching the breed and following the statistics through the Official Pages. The statistics which led me to this breed stated that Westies will place in group competition 68% of the time with a large percentage of that in Group 1 or Group 2 placements. This was a time when Westies were in competition quite a bit as compared to now.

My second Westie was born Dec. 1985, Sallydean's Duglad of Damara, bred by Sally Bremner of Sallydean Kennels. He quickly made up to a Canadian champion despite my inability to groom correctly. Denis Springer of Vancouver, Washington put his US title on him quickly, making "Doogie" #4 Westie in Canada and #8 in the US within 3 months of campaigning. Doogie was a multiple Best in Show dog in both countries. Doogie was truly a family dog with two young boys to play with and a family to call his own. He was used at stud producing many healthy and pretty Westies for me and was used a bit by outside breeders to approved bitches. It was important to me to advertise his attributes, although Terrier Type magazine published an in-depth article of the influence of Whitebriar Jeronimo, Doogie's sire, placing Doogie as one of Jeronimo's Top Ten producing sons.

I was sponsored in 1986 into the BC All Terrier Club by Sally Bremner and Rose Parker.

The 1990's were a busy time for me: we moved to Summerland in the Okanagan, had two sons to raise, dogs to care for and show in competition and Thoroughbred horses as well. In 1995 I had a most memorable year as that year I bred several litters for spring/summer puppies and 5 bitches all became in whelp. I had 19 Westie puppies! What a treasured time to have this number all playing in the sunshine together, all tattooed at an early age to positively identify them. Many of these puppies went on to championships.

Through all this I was a working member of the Skaha Kennel Club, newsletter editor of the Westie News for 6 years and Breedlines contributor to Dogs in Canada for 5 years with a bi-monthly column. I showed extensively and traveled to many shows: Calgary specialties, five times to Montgomery County, showing once, Great Western, traveling with Denis Springer and other women, grooming and bathing multiple Westies multiple times each day. And of course lots of local shows, only a few of which were within a short drive.

I bred from 1986 to 2001 with about 3 litters per year. Female puppies dominated over male puppies by 30%. I used primarily two male lines of Whitebriar and Poolmist of the UK. Both these lines proved themselves over time by producing healthy dogs which lived long lives. All my pets were sold on a non-breeding agreement with a "right of first refusal" should they need to be re-homed. Only a few ever came back as I had very strict criteria for purchasers. All these people became clan members of Damara!

So now to my statistics which really don't tell the story of how I look back on my activities and which I will elaborate. I always received the greatest satisfaction of breeding healthy, well-tempered Westies who could live out their lives with a family, free of skin disorders and temperament issues. I believe the definition of a pet was that of a beautiful dog of which owners could be justly proud. And my owners always showed great pride in their dogs. For those years of dedication and belief in what I was doing, I take a great deal of quiet satisfaction.

SHOW WINS

The Tyee K.C. shows May 13-15 drew a good entry of terriers, no doubt due in part to the club's terrier booster on the Saturday which drew an entry of 45. Exhibitors and spectators were treated to snacks and drinks at ringside during the event as they watched the terriers under Mrs Glenys Alexander of Australia. Her group winner was a Min. Schnauzer puppy that she took on to BPIS, owned by Brian Kruse. Group 3rd went to the Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice** owned by Jackie Marriott, with Group 4th to the Norwich, **Ch. Amblegreen's Rickard's Red** owned by Sandy Keller and Heather Tomlins. The previous day, Jacqueline Rusby took another Min. Schnauzer puppy to BPIG and BPIS, **Minuteman Safety Last**, owned by new member Krystal Mason with Cathy McMillan. Rusby also gave Group 2nd to the Norwich, and Group 3rd to Hollie Ben-Yosef's Min. Schnauzer **Ch. Envoy Express II Knockout**. The last day Hal Pybus also gave the Norwich Group 2nd.

At the Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers shows May 27-29, terriers were judged by Walter Pinsker, Bud Haverstock and Mary White. The consistent winners were Scotties and Min. Schnauzers. Both Haverstock and White placed Barry Truax's Scottie, **Ch. Glenfraser's Alexander Of Gallica**, Group 2nd, with Pinsker giving Jackie Marriott 's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice**, Group 3rd. Hollie Ben-Yosef's Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Envoy Express II Knockout**, went Group 3rd under Haverstock, and Group 4th under the other two judges.



At the Comox Valley shows June 11 & 12, the Norwich, **Ch. Amblegreen's Rickard's Red**, owned by Sandy Keller and Heather Tomlins, took a Group 2nd under Brent Wright and Group 4th with Dianne Ivey. The Min. Schnauzer, **Minuteman Safety Last**, owned by Krystal Mason went Group 4th under Wright, and Hollie Ben-Yosef's Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Envoy Express II Knockout**, went Group 2nd under Lynn Storeshaw.

At the Nanaimo K.C. shows June 17-19, Larisa Hotchin's Welsh Terrier, **Ch.
