## TOP TERRIERS FOR 2015!

*Nine Club Members' Dogs Rank Nationally in the Top 5*

According to the CKC and *Canuckdogs.com* tabulations of Top Dog standings, the following 9 dogs owned by club members placed in the top 5 of their breeds in Canada this year, according to *Dogs in Canada's* Top Dog point system. This includes the 5 breed leaders in Australian, Border, Lakeland, Wheaten and Welsh, with the Border ranked as #2 Terrier with 4 BIS and almost 2400 points, and the Welsh with 1 BIS and 862 points – an amazing accomplishment for a small club! In addition, another 6 dogs placed in the top 10 of their breeds for a total of 15 dogs owned by club members.

### SHOW WINS

Janis Trozduk reports that **Am. Ch. Can. GCh. Trotters Man In Black** (aka Cole) at 2 years of age, completed 2014 as **#4 Scottish Terrier** in Canada and also earned his **Canadian Grand Championship title**. In 2015, with limited showing in the United States, at the Puyallup shows, Cole earned his **American Championship title** and continued onto the Rose City shows gathering majors and points towards his American Grand Championship requirements. Coming back home, Cole completed 2015, with numerous group placements and ranked in Canada as **#3 Scottish Terrier**, under the guidance of Cynthia Seeling. Almost a year to the date of earning his American Championship, again in Puyallup, January 2016, Cole won 5 point majors and attained his **American Grand Championship title**, this time being presented by Cassidy Furlong, a junior handler.



The 2016 show year started with the Ladies K.C. shows Feb. 5-7. On Friday, Martin Doherty gave Group 2<sup>nd</sup> to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice Encore**, and Best Puppy to the American Staffordshire, **Michl R I Only Date Models**, owned by Kelly Thorburn & Nelli Larjava, and he took the puppy on to BPIS. The next day, Geraldine Taylor gave Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and Best Puppy to the AmStaff, with Group 3<sup>rd</sup> going to the Norwich, **Amblegreen Dralion Maui Mokka**, owned by Heather Tomlins and handled by Cyndy Monk. On Sunday, Ray Smith gave Group 3<sup>rd</sup> and Best Puppy to the AmStaff and took it on to BPIS, with Group 4<sup>th</sup> going to the Scottie.

The Mt Cheam Canine Assoc. shows followed on Feb. 26-28. Jocelyne Gagne awarded Group 1<sup>st</sup> to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice Encore**, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **GCh. Cashel's Oban On Ice**. On Saturday, club member Karsten Kaemling gave Group 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Wheaten, Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to the Norwich, **Amblegreen Dralion Maui Mokka**, owned by Heather Tomlins and handled by Cyndy Monk, and Group 4<sup>th</sup> to the Scottie, **GCh. Trotter Man in Black**, owned by Janis Trozduk, with the same placements the next day by Stanley Shen to the Wheaten Norwich and Scottie.

It was her 3<sup>rd</sup> Best Puppy Specialty Sweeps win. A few days later, Hattie completed her US title with her 4<sup>th</sup> major win under Canadian judge Mike MacBeth. Hattie's breeding is by Am. Ch. Paragon's Focus On The Gold ex Can/Am Ch. Minuteman Spanish Fly. At the same show, **Ch. Dreamaker Red Red Wine** ("Merlot") was WB, BW and BOS for a 5-point major under judge Judith Daniels. She then went on to win a Group 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Bred by Owner event. Last November, Merlot won a Best Bred By in Show in Roseburg, Oregon. She has added two more major wins at a recent show in Albany, Oregon and only needs a couple of single points to complete her US title. Merlot is by Can/Am Ch. Empire's Red October ex Ch. Glenmeadows Musical Note.



At the Puyallup / Portland circuit Larisa Hotchin's boy Mickey, Ch. Darwyn's Sorcerer's Apprentice was awarded BW and BOB for a major at the Welsh Terrier breed specialty and then Group 1st in the bred-by group for the Terrier specialty! ## IN MEMORIAM: ALLYN POWER (1952-2015)

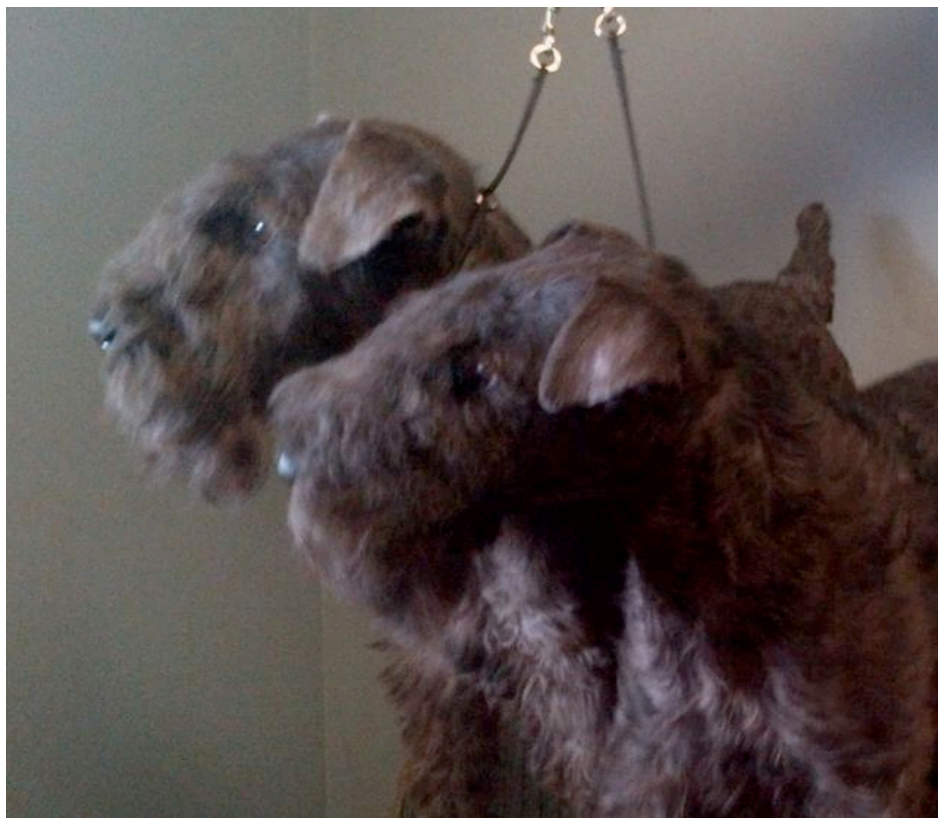
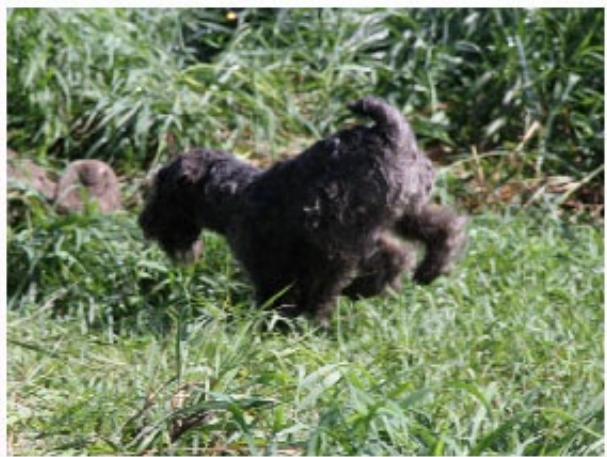
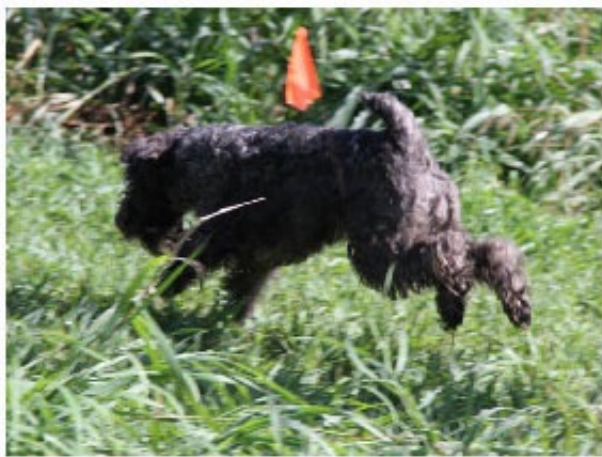
It is with sadness that we only recently heard about the passing of one of our BCATC members in Alberta last year, Allyn Power, an avid Lakeland breeder (Threlfall). Here is the information we have been able to find.

Allyn passed away peacefully at the Foothills Medical Centre in Calgary on Wednesday, April 29, 2015 surrounded by family. She was born in Winnipeg and attended Linwood School, Deer Lodge Jr High, St. James Collegiate, University of Winnipeg and University of Manitoba. Allyn received a BA and a B. Comm and went on to become an accountant. After moving to Ft. McMurray where she met Doug, their life literally went to the dogs. Allyn became an avid dog breeder of Lakeland Terriers and was a member of the Alberta Terrier Club, Alberta Kennel Club and several others. Allyn volunteered for several organizations, including the Town of Okotoks, PALS (Pet Access League Society), PAWS (Positive Animal Wellness Support), and the AATC (American All Terrier Club) to name a few.

She will be lovingly remembered by her husband of 29 years, Douglas Michael, siblings Marian Power of Ottawa ON, brother-in-law Hellar Nakonechny of Carmen MB, Heather Power (Harold Klause) of Winnipeg MB, Dawn Power (Guy Arbez) of Winnipeg MB, Ian Power (Kathy Kendall Power) of Calgary AB. Also missing Allyn will be Doug's family, Betty, David, Susan and Laura, as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Allyn was most proud of some of her "blue" Lakelands that she had (they have 9 colours, and she liked the less common ones, even though in so many ways – breeding, judging, etc. – they are harder to have). Allyn came out to some of the BCATC Specialties at the Tradex with her Lakelands and one time she had a blue brace which took a Best Brace in Show in Alberta. In later years, she was active in earthdog and barn hunt events as can be seen from the pictures below, where her dogs earned various AKC titles.







Cassidy Furlong and her mother Marlene have been away to Jackson, Tennessee and Las Vegas showing Crush in Juniors and Breed (March 24 - 27, 2016). In Jackson, Cassidy and Crush placed first in Juniors all four days. In the NOHS they placed all four days with three Group 1's and a Group 2. In Las Vegas at Prim Valley, Cassidy and Crush took Reserve Best Junior and a second placement in Juniors as well as, Crush went BOS both days earning two 3 point majors.
