## BCATC SPECIALTY SHOW 2012

The club's annual Specialty show was held **Thursday, October 25**, in conjunction with Canada's largest show, Lower Mainland Dog Fanciers at the Tradex in Abbotsford. **David Kirkland** from North Carolina judged all breeds and the Group. The Puppy & Juvenile Sweeps judge was club life member **Anita Norman** and the Obedience Specialty judge was **Bruce Fraser**. Entries were 134 in Conformation, 25 in Sweeps and 8 in Obedience (up from last year). The National Specialty for Cairn Terriers and one sponsored by the Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Canada were also held, along with several breed-sponsored prizes.

### MONTGOMERY COUNTY NEWS

A 9-month old Scottie bred by Heather & David Lindberg, **MacBrechin's Monopoly Beinnein**, now owned by Darle Heck, sired by Glenby's Secret Treasure out of Heather & David Lindberg's Ch. Beinnein's Ceilidh MacBrechin, made his very first show ring appearance at the Montgomery weekend of shows. On his first day in a show ring at Hatboro, he took Winner's Dog for a 4 point major. On his second day at Hatboro, he got another 4 point major with the same win. On his third day out at Devon, he went Best of Winners for a 5 point major. At Montgomery he didn't get any points but he won his class, 9 to 12 month puppy. What a debut! And top it off, he finished his American Championship in grand style with a 5-point major at the Greater Washington Scottish Terrier Specialty under breeder judge Barbara Casey, all at 9 months. One blogger (Billy Wheeler in the *Best in Show Daily*) commented: "I also will remember two Scotties, one I have seen many times, the RBIS at the Devon Dog Show Association Saturday show, GCh Ch. Lomondview Clementina, and one I had not seen before, the nine month old winners dog at Devon, Macbrechin's Monopoly Beinnein. The former has an exquisite head piece and never lets up in the ring. The latter also has a beautiful head and movement and the kind of Terrier-tude that keeps me in love with the breed."



Also in Montgomery news, Joy Viel reports, "Wow, Montgomery weekend turned out to be better than I ever dreamed of. Wonderful dogs, great people and so proud of my boy (**Ch. Red Branch d'Artagnan of the Ring**)! Winner of the Irish Terrier Sweepstakes and he and Joe Metz (his breeder/co-owner) were named Best Bred By in Specialty! Their names will be on the wonderful Cocksure/Robert Clyde memorial trophy! Love my boy d'Artagnan!"

Ken & Eline Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Can/Am Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** ("Ace") was shown at the American Miniature Schnauzer National Specialty at Montgomery County KC in October where he finished his US Championship by being awarded Winners dog and an Award of Merit at 12 months of age. Ace is the #1 Miniature Schnauzer puppy for 2012 in Canada and ended this year as #3 Miniature Schnauzer in the country!



Larisa Hotchin also attended the Montgomery County shows and reports on Darwyn Welsh Terriers at that weekend: 2 BOB wins for a Darwyn bred Welsh (Monty's sister - GCh Am. Darwyn Esmeralda in Sanherpine), RWD (Zorro - the group winning Welsh Terrier from the Victoria show last summer) and Best Opposite Sex in sweeps for a 6 month old puppy, **Darwyn's Special Blend** (Java), handled by Larisa! This is the 13th time attending Montgomery and it is as exciting as the first few times - so many beautiful terriers, in beautiful condition, handled to perfection with club dinners, club boutiques and lots of breeders and dogs to see and spend time with - a "must-attend" event for all terrier breeders.

#### NEW CHAMPIONS & TITLEHOLDERS

Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Annfield Smooth Moves**, made his ring debut handled by Don Emslie at the Lower Mainland Dog Fanciers October shows and gathered nine points towards his Champion title. "Strider" was shown the following weekend by his co-owner Shannon Taylor at the Red Deer show to finish his title. Strider is sired by Am/Can Ch. Annfield Its a Riot out of Am/Can Ch. Annfield Smooth Turn and was bred by Don Emslie, Tim Doxtater and Norley Smith and is owned by Don Emslie, Tim Doxtater, Shannon Taylor and Michelle Copeland. Strider will now venture to the USA in pursuit of his U.S. title.

## SHOW WINS

The four-day Fraser Valley Dog Fanciers shows were held Oct. 5-8 at Cloverdale, with terriers being judges by Grant Townsend, Jane Forsyth, Gabriels Valdez-Valdes and Linda Millman. Townsend gave group 4<sup>th</sup> to Florence Yunik's Sealyham, **Ch. Glenwell Didgeridoo**, Forsyth gave Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice Treasure**, and Best Puppy to Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Empire's Dancing Til Dawn**. Valdes took Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Dunsmuir's BlackNsilver Elegance**, from the classes to Group 2<sup>nd</sup>, and Millman gave Group 4<sup>th</sup> to Vicki Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Empire's Vanilla Bean**, and Best Puppy to her **Empire's Dancing Til Dawn**.

At the Alberni Valley shows Oct. 12-14, without the Welsh or Westie Special there, the terrier group opened up and Sharon Derrick started the weekend off by giving Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir's Black Ice Treasure**, Best in Show! This is only the 3<sup>rd</sup> BIS win by a Scottie this year. It came from a Group 1<sup>st</sup> given by Guy Jeavons, who placed Vicki Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Empire's Vanilla Bean**, Group 2<sup>nd</sup>. Derrick also gave the group to the Scottie, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to the Min. Schnauzer. Mark Houston-McMillan completed the hat trick for the Scottie, with Group 4<sup>th</sup> to the Min. Schnauzer, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to Kelly Greir's Westie, **Mysticgold's Power Play**.

The Lower Mainland all-breed shows 25-28 attracted the expected large entry, though noticeably fewer members of the public, with excellent dogs being shown from across the country, and the usual panel of international judges. On Thursday, Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Am GCh & Can Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**, won the Terrier Group under Australian judge Jocelyn Croad, with Group 3<sup>rd</sup> going to Ronald and Pearl Humenny's Border, **Ch. Benchmark's Winning Goal**, and Group 4<sup>th</sup> to Ken and Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer**. On Friday, Malaysian judge Tan Hock placed the Welsh Group 4<sup>th</sup>. On Saturday, the Uruguayan judge Sergio Pizzorno placed Joy Viel's Irish Terrier, **Ch. Red Branch d'Artagnan of the Ring**, Group 2<sup>nd</sup>, and the Welsh Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. Best Bred By Exhibitor went to Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Empire's Dancing Til Dawn**. The last day, American judge James Frederiksen gave the group to the Welsh, Group 2<sup>nd</sup> to the Irish, and Best Bred By to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Darwyn's Special Blend**. So, club members did quite well at this highly competitive show.

Heather Tomlins reports that Amblegreen is pleased to announce that "Kona" (**Am/Can Ch. Amblegreen Top Notch**) finished his US Championship in May at the combined Spokane/Couer d'Alene shows. Kona needed 1 point and he finished in limited showing with a final 5 point major all from Bred By at 17 months. In Canada, he has only been shown in two shows – Lower Mainland Dog Fanciers - Tradex 2011 and then again in 2012. He finished on **Friday** of Tradex going Best of Winners. Also at the Tradex show his first daughter was shown and **Amblegreen Tutti Frutti** did very well. Over the 5 available shows she picked up 7 points all from Bred By at 7 months of age (see photo next page). Her Dam is GCh/MBPIS Can Ch. Amblegreen Bikini Blonde and "Tutti" is so like Spice so we are thrilled. This year we only attended one US and one Canadian show, but did have a few litters and hope to show off some of the other 'kids' in 2013...



At the Elsie Murray Canine Centre shows, Nov. 23-25, Luiz Ribas Silva of Brazil, Geraldine Taylor, and Brent Wright judged terriers. Silva's group winner was Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Am GCh & Can Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**, with Group 3<sup>rd</sup> going to Ken & Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer**. Best Puppy in Group was won all three days by John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice**. Local judge Brent Wright placed the Welsh Group 2<sup>nd</sup> and the Min. Schnauzer Group 3<sup>rd</sup>; Geraldine Taylor's group winner was the Welsh and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> to the Min. Schnauzer.

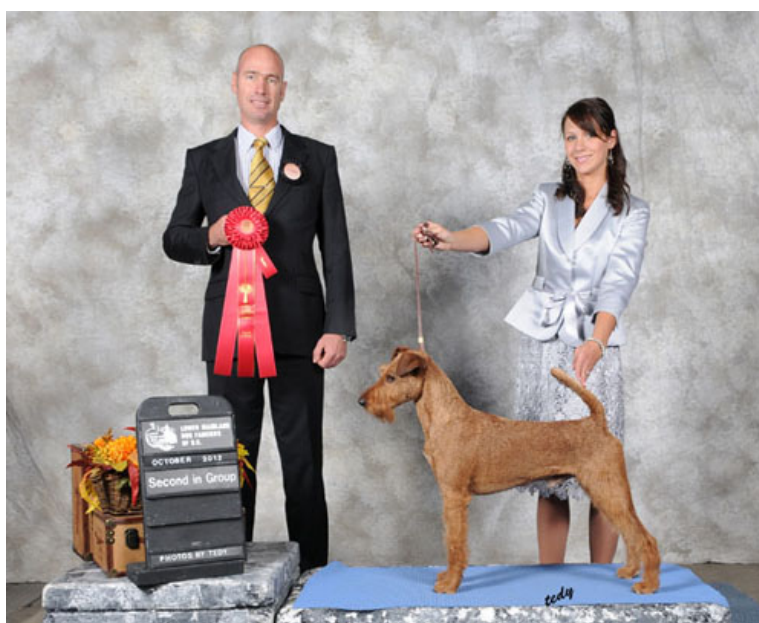

### News from Darwyn Welsh Terriers:

The last quarter of 2012 has been very exciting for Larisa and Michael of Darwyn Welsh Terriers. Most of our club members know about Joe (**GCh Am. & Can Ch. Darwyn's I'm Not Arguing That**), but many might not remember that this is the first dog that they have done a full year campaign on - and 2012 has been the 2nd full year campaign with Joe! The last show of the year is over - Auld Lang Syne (yes - they are not flying out to Ontario for the Elora Gorge shows), and Joe won 1 of the 3 Terrier groups (under Mr. Charles Trotter) and was Group 2<sup>nd</sup> the other 2 days. This follows a few weekends where he was not shown (and hence lost the #1 terrier position), and in fact, this is after Joe had been home for 2 weeks! Joe's handler of the last 2 years, Milton Lopes, moved back to Brazil.

Some of the more memorable wins for Joe during the last few months of 2012 is the American BIS, two Group Wins at Tradex, a Group win under breeder-judge Mrs. Taylor, the weekend in SK where he won 4 BIS and the final show of the year at ALS where he won the group! Michael and Larisa are extremely proud of Joe. He finishes off 2012 with 148 career group wins (6 in California), 29 Best in Shows (1 in the US), 4 Best in Terrier Specialties, #2 Terrier overall for both 2011 and 2012 and a Top 10 dog among all breeds also for both 2011 and 2012, as well as many prestigious US wins. Joe was born as a singleton puppy and Larisa will always keep in mind that it only takes one to be a "great one"! Of course, it's important to have good quality parents - both Joe's sire and dam are top quality Welsh - both are US National Specialty winners. Joe is now retired in Canada.



Now "Down Under" has also been very exciting these last few months for Welsh Terrier Parker (**Am/Can/Aust Ch. Darwyn's Webslinger**) and his co-owner that is showing him. Parker has only been shown 8 weekends in Australia and has been awarded in total 8 Terrier Group Wins, 2 Runner up Groups (like a Group 2), a Reserve Best in Show and a Best Open in Show! He finishes off 2012 as the #2 Welsh Terrier in Australia. Four of these top wins have been under top Terrier breeder specialists - one who is Neville Hodgkins, who judged terrier breeds AND Best in Show at Devon and Hatboro (Montgomery weekend) 2012, while his partner Kerry Lee judged the Terrier Group at Hatboro 2012. Another prominent judge that gave Parker a top award is Keith Lovell, well known for his Airedales and Welsh Terriers and who judged BIS at Montgomery in 2011. Wayne Lewis is another well-known terrier specialist to have awarded Parker a Terrier Group Win. Larisa and Michael are extremely proud and honored to have had such prestigious judges to have awarded top honours to Parker and provided very exciting and detailed written critiques of him. Sonya, Parker's co-owner, will not be actively campaigning him, but will show him a bit during 2013.

Larisa is now off to Florida for the big Eukanuba / AKC National event in Orlando - her 5th "AKC / Eukanuba" event. This time no dogs will be shown of Darwyn's as the judge is someone that she has co-owned with. But, Zorro (**Ch. Darwyn Don Diego de la Vega**) will be handed over to his new co-owner to spend the next year in South America!
