SHOW WINS

Janis Trotzuk (Trotters Scotties) reports that **Can. GCh./Am. Ch. Trotters Man In Black**, "Cole," who is the offspring of Am/Can Ch. Bookmaker De Champernoune and Can/Am Ch. McVan's Wildfire At Trotters, achieved his Canadian championship with limited showing at nine months of age. Cole completed the year 2014 with numerous group placements and ranked #4 Scottish Terrier in Canada. By making these wins, Cole also attained his Grand Championship title in Canada.


The challenge was then to begin his quest for an American title. In January 2015, Cole began and completed that goal by winning 5 consecutive shows, (Best of Winners) in the Puyallup and Portland circuit with 5 sets of major points, 2 Best of Breed and a Best of Opposite Sex. After starting the year 2015 at US shows, Cole came home and proceeded to own the Scottie ring. At this time he has 6 Group 1st wins, a Best In Specialty win, a number of Best of Breed wins and continues with multiple group wins.

While at the Washington State Scottish Terrier Specialty Show in June 2015, Cole was invited to take part in their TOP 20 Competition, which recognized those Scottish Terriers with the most outstanding records in the show ring during the previous calendar year. In this competition, Cole was handled by Cassidy Furlong, a senior class, junior handler. In the **WSSCTC** Specialty, Cole was again expertly handled by Cassidy. She competed in the Washington State Junior Handler Competition, judged by Mr. Clay Coady, who awarded her the title of **Washington State Scottish Terrier Junior Handler for 2015** – an honour to be recognized by a former handler and now a prestigious Terrier judge.

Pearl Humenny reports that her Border Terrier, **GCh. Benchmark's Winning Goal**, a.k.a. Keeper, "our little brown dog, is having an amazing year and we are just at the midpoint. Keeper started off 2015 with a Group 1 in the States at a show in Niagara Falls, New York. This was followed by several more US Group placements in January and February. In March, he was awarded Best In Show at the Scarborough Show by Judge Richard Lopaschuk, and at the Sudbury Show by Judge Joy Hodgkinson. In April, at the Guelph Show he was given top honours by Judge David Swartwood, and in June, at the Monarch Show, Judge Hodgkinson found him again. So far, in his career, Keeper has been awarded 6 Bests in Show, which is significant for the breed. We are honoured and humbled by the recognition our homebred boy has received. Within the next few months two of Keeper's sons will make their debut in the ring, one in the US and one in Canada."



Joy Viel reports on **Can Ch./Am GCh. Red Branch d'Artagnan of the Ring Cgn**: What a weekend d'Artagnan and I had at Great Western! Once again a huge thank-you goes to his breeders Joe & Elena Metz who picked us up at the airport in San Francisco and we headed down to Long Beach. The Queen Mary Events Park was a wonderful venue for a dog show and what an awesome group of terriers!! Elena helped with finishing touches on my grooming each day and I owner handled my handsome boy. As the weekend progressed the smile on my face got bigger....

As well, Wicka's little 1/2 brother Ryker, also sired by Dart, is waiting for his rabies shot so that his new owners can come and pick him up and take him home to Northern California and play with him in the conformation rings down there. This puppy is developing a good 'outline' and should be a lot of fun for his owners to show.

At the Lakes District K.C. shows May 2-3, Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **GCh. Trotters Man In Black**, won all four of the small terrier groups.

The Tyee K.C. shows were held in Duncan on May 8-10. On Friday, under Ed MacDonald, Caren Holtby's Australian, **Ch. Tidewalker Diamond Glory**, went Group 2nd, with Joanne Helm's Airedale, **Indus Archer**, going Group 4th, and her puppy **Indus I Wish I Had A Bentley** taking Puppy Group. On Saturday, John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **GCh. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, went Group 3rd under Martin Doherty, with the Australian taking Group 4th. On Sunday, Brent Wright awarded the Group to the Wheaten with the Australian taking Group 4th.

Vancouver Island Dog Fanciers held four shows May 22-24 in Saanichton. The first day, Russel Fletcher awarded Group 1st to John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **GCh. The second day, Anne Katona gave Group 2nd to Ken & Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Dreamaker Game On**, Group 3rd to James Kidner's Scottie, **Brueik's Super Trouper**, Group 4th to the Welsh, and Best Puppy to Ken & Elaine Allen's **Dreamaker Stunt Wing Walker.** Ilean Danby's brace of Cairns went Best Brace in Show. On Sunday, Oscar Valverde-Calvo, gave Group 2nd to the Scottie, Group 3rd to the Cairn, and Group 4th to the Min. Schnauzer, with Carmen Haller giving Best Brace on Show to the Cairns. On Monday, Carmen Haller gave Group 2nd to the Welsh.

Comox Valley K.C. held 6 shows June 13-16. Richard Paquette gave Group 3rd to Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Dunsmuir Black Ice Devil**, and Best Baby Puppy to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Darwyn's Sakura**. Robert Shreve gave Group 3rd to Anita Norman's Kerry Blue, **Irisblu The Harpist**, and Best Puppy to Ken & Elaine Allen's **Dreamaker Stunt Wing Walker** (who finished her Canadian Championship at this show). Wayne Thompson gave Group 4th to Ken & Elaine Allen's **GCh. Dreamaker High Flyer.** Phyllis Pancel gave Group 2nd to the Scottie and Group 3rd to the Min. Schnauzer. At the Specialty Stella went Best of Breed from the classes with a nice entry of 15 for her first major and then went on to a Group 4. She went Best of Breed again the following day for her second major – a lovely start for this young girl. Stella is bred by Heather Tomlins and Linda Dowdle, owned by Heather Tomlins and handled by Cyndy Monk. She is out of Heather's Spice (MBPIS Can Ch/Am Ch Amblegreen Bikini Blonde) and sired by Ch. Fairewood Forever Blue Jeans.



At the mid-year mark, <u>Canuckdogs.com</u> reports in its standings that our club members have three dogs in the top 12 of the Terrier Group (all of which lead their own breeds): Pearl Humenny's Border Terrier, **GCh. Benchmark's Winning Goal,** is currently #2, Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Can. Ch. & Am GCh. Darwyn's Bruhil's Flying Circus,** is #6, and John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **GCh. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, is at #11. Obviously a lot can change during the rest of the year, but so far it looks very good for those dogs, and hopefully others. Let's keep our fingers crossed!

Darwyn Welsh Terriers were represented at this year's World Dog Show in Milan Italy in June! For the World Dog Show, there are two shows to enter. One that is called a Club Show, and this is the equivalent to a Terrier Group Specialty in North America; however, only breed level awards are provided (i.e. no group placements), and the actual World Dog Show. Welsh Terrier "Trooper" – **Can Ch & Am Bronze Grand Ch Darwyn Here for a Good Time**, attended both of these shows. Over 30 Welsh Terriers were entered and shown. At the Club Show, Trooper, who is owned & bred by Larisa Hotchin and co-owned by Sonya Cornick of Australia, was awarded the CAC (which is the equivalent to WD here) and then onto BOB over the champion class Welsh Terriers, under the well know terrier expert judge from Sweden, Dan Ericsson. At the WDS, the judge, from Italy, chose an Italian dog to win the open class and CAC, and another Italian dog to win BOB.



Pacific K.C. held its annual shows over the course of four days at Hazlemere Campground in Surrey, July 23-26. Denys Janssen judged 22 terriers the first day and awarded the Group to John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **GCh. Cashel's Oban On Ice** and Best Puppy to Ken & Elaine Allen's **Maiha Dreamaker Trying My Luck.** The second day, the show went on during an unusual downpour of rain, so no one was exactly looking their best. However, Edna St Hilaire also gave the group to the Wheaten, Best Puppy to the Min. Schnauzer, and Group 4th to Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **Am. Ch. & GCh. Trotters Man In Black.** The third day, Linda Kraft judged terriers in better weather and gave the Wheaten Group 2nd. On Sunday there was another downpour, but the show didn't stop despite puddles everywhere in the rings. Dianne Ivey awarded the group to the Wheaten (making it a hat-trick of 3 out of 4), Group 4th to the Scottie and Best Puppy in Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Darwyn's Sorcerer's Apprentice**.

Despite the bad weather, some dogs were able to finish at this show. Heather and David Lindberg's female Scottie, **MacBrechin's Callanish Cricket**, went Best of Winners each day, and Best of Breed over Specials the first day to finish her Canadian Championship, and Ken & Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer, **Maiha Dreamaker Trying My Luck**, also finished her Championship.
