The club's annual Specialty show will be held **Saturday, June 16**, in conjunction with the Nanaimo K.C. shows which will be held at the beautiful **Arbutus Meadows Equestrian Centre** (1515 Island Highway) in conjunction with four all-breed shows, so **5** sets of points. The noted terrier judge **Roger Hartinger** from Ohio will judge all breeds and the Group. The Puppy, Juvenile & Veteran Sweeps judge will be **Janine Starink**. There will not be an all-terrier Obedience Trial but in the all-breed Rally Trial, a prize will be offered to the highest qualifying terrier. Junior handling for all terriers is also being planned, also judged by **Janine Starink**.

Prizes and rosettes will be awarded to the Group placing winners (for other breed prizes consult the premium list). Best in Specialty and Best Puppy will receive a limited edition signed print by Nancy Popovich. Currently, Boosters and Supported entries have not been determined. Non-regular classes for Baby Puppy, Brace, Stud Dog and Brood Bitch will also be offered.

At 13 months of age, she was both a Canadian and American Champion. At 15 months, she attained her Canadian Grand Championship. She got her Canadian Championship in one weekend in Kenora, Ontario, with me at the other end of the lead. Gracie was shown by Will Alexander to her AKC Championship, with all majors, garnered at the Brevard KC and Central Florida KC Shows in Florida in December; and at the Livonia Shows in January. In February, with Celeste Bennet handling, Gracie got her Canadian Grand Championship.

Gracie was the top Terrier puppy in Manitoba for 2017, and was honoured at Paws For Celebration on April 7, 2018 with a framed certificate, huge rosette and picture. Gracie has been awarded Group placements in both Canada and the USA and is currently top Border Terrier in Canada. Pearl is very proud of this little dog's accomplishments to date.

SHOW WINS

The show year in BC didn't start until the end of February, and, not surprisingly, there are some new dogs in the ring with their handlers. David Gignac has a new Westie, Ch. Skyehigh's One Pound Sterling, with one BIS so far, and is being seriously challenged by a Kerry Blue, Ch. Krisma's Xman First Class, shown in BC by Aaron Andriash, and Connie Krohn elsewhere, who already has 6 BIS and is currently #1 Dog in Canada. Jennifer Knudsen is showing Heather Tomlins' young Norwich, **Ch. Dralion's Amblegreen Mavi Gold**, and for the first show her partner Fano showed a Dandie Dinmont. At the BC shows so far, the judging panels have been mainly international judges from many countries, so the results are sometimes unpredictable, but overall, most seem competent with terriers.

At the Washington State All Terrier Specialty in Puyallup Jan. 12/18, Barry Truax's Scottie, **Ch. MacBrechin's Rolling Thunder**, "Dougal", co-owned with Denis Blais and Heather Lindberg, scored a 5-point major going Best of Winners under Karen Ericson. A great way to start his career in the US!



The Mt Cheam shows Feb. 23-25 started the year with Pedro Gonzalez-Teja of Guatemala judging the first day. He gave Heather Tomlins' young Norwich, **Ch. Dralion's Amblegreen Mavi Gold**, the Group 3rd, with Best Puppy going to a former club member, Catherine Hamilton, who was back with a young Westie handled by David Gignac. Best Owner Handled went to Judy Hodgkins' Wheaten **Hion When Sparks Fly** (see photo page 9). The second day, Garry Dryburgh from Australia placed the terriers mentioned in the previous paragraph in the order of Kerry, Westie and Dandie, with Group 4th going to the Norwich. Best Baby Puppy went to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Darwyn's Serendipity at SF** who repeated the win the last day under Andy Gong from China.

In Rally Obedience at Mt Cheam, Ilean Danby's Cairn, **GCh. Grayfriar's Max CGN, RA** took Best Overall Veteran in the all-breed Sweeps, as well as taking 95 & 96 point passes in Rally Advanced.

The Victoria City K.C. shows followed on March 2-4 in Duncan. Arne Foss from Norway gave Group 3rd to Janis Trotzuk's Scottie, **GCh. Trotters Man In Black**, with Best Owner Handled going to John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **Ch. Greentree Preakness Express To Cashel**. The next day, Francesco Cochetti from Italy gave Group 3rd to Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **Can/Am GCh. Empire Dreamaker Hot Tip**, co-bred by Vicki with Ken & Elaine Allen. Best Bred By went to Sandi Malcom's Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Mimicker's CurtainUpBernadette**. The last day, Darle Heck gave the Scottie Group 3rd and Best Owner Handled to the Wheaten.



Ilean Danby's Cairn, **GCh. Grayfriar's Max CGN, RA** took BW, Best of Breed, and Group 2nd, beating over 90 dogs, and Best Owner Handler in Group on the Saturday at the Seattle Kennel Club show. Sadly, due to the current breed count, this was only worth one championship point. See the photo next page. **Iz's Red Moon Rising** (a Max daughter) took Winners Bitch for her first US point at the same show.



The Oceanside K.C. shows were held in Chilliwack March 30 - April 2. The first day, Gail Forsythe gave Group 2nd, Best Puppy, and Best Owner Handled to Judy Hodgkins' Wheaten **Hion When Sparks Fly**, Group 3rd to an AmStaff bred by Kelly Thorburn, **Michl R Who Dated Who**, and Group 4th to Heather Tomlins' Norwich, **Ch. Dralion's Amblegreen Mavi Gold**. The second day, Francis Smith Moffat from Argentina gave Group 3rd to Vicki & Greg Stephens' Min. Schnauzer, **GCh. Empire Dreamaker Hot Tip**, Group 4th to a new Sealyham import, **Rosgarnds Eirian Morrison**, owned by Florence Yunik and Sarah Sweatt, Best Baby Puppy to Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Darwyn's Serendipity at SF**, and Best Bred By to Judy Hodgkins' Wheaten. This judge was quite remarkable in terms of the running commentary she gave exhibitors while going over their dog or afterwards – information that seemed quite perceptive about each breed, all this while keeping to schedule, and a practice that might well be imitated. The third day, Ekarat Sangkunakup from Thailand gave Group 2nd to the Norwich, Group 3rd to the Schnauzer and Group 4th and Best Owner Handled to the Wheaten. The last day, Sharron Taylor from Australia, filling in for another Australian Cheryl Currie, gave Group 3rd to the Norwich, Group 4th to the Sealyham, Best Bred By to the Wheaten, and Best Baby Puppy to the Welsh, **Darwyn's Serendipity at SF**.

Florence Yunik reports that **Rosgarnds Eirian Morrison** is the new addition to the Sealyham crew at Rocglen kennels. Morrison comes from a Danish line of Sealys and was imported from the US. He is co-owned by Florence Yunik and Sarah Sweatt. He made his Canadian show debut at Oceanside show where Francis Smith from Argentina and Sharron Taylor from Australia awarded Morrison Group 4th placements. Dralion's Amblegreen Mavi Gold** (“Stitch”) and her handler Jennifer Knudsen went Group 2nd on the **Friday**, and Group 4th on the **Saturday** of the Mount Cheam show in February. At the Oceanside Shows in March, Stitch and Jen earned a Group 4th on the **Friday**, Group 2nd on the **Sunday** and Group 3rd on the **Monday**. At the Auld Lang Syne show on the **Thursday** Stitch and Jen went Group 3rd in a strong group of Terriers. Stitch and I will be heading to Purina Farms for our Norwich Nationals the first week in May... excited to see all the Norwich there...





Judy Hodgkins' "Stella"

The Auld Lang Syne and Renaissance clubs collaborated again this year on a combined set of shows spanning 5 days, April 12-16, plus the Terrier Breeders' Specialty (see results elsewhere in the newsletter). As with all the previous shows this year, the majority of judges were international. The first day, Juan Alberto Grillo from Colombia judged terriers and placed Heather Tomlins' Norwich Group 3rd, **Am/Can Ch. Dralion's Amblegreen Mavi Gold**, and Ilean Danby's Cairn, **GCh. Grayfriar's Max CGN, RA**, Group 4th and Best Veteran. The second day, Ronnie Natividad from the Philippines, gave Best Puppy to Ilean Danby's **Iz's Red Moon Rising** who also teamed up with **Saucydog's Sparkle Boy** for Best Brace. Best Bred By went to Judy Hodgkins' Wheaten **Hion When Sparks Fly**. The third day, Hassi Assenmacher-Feyel from Germany gave Best Baby Puppy to Larisa Welsh's **Darwyn's Leading Edge**. The fourth day, Aida Rivera Franco from Colombia gave Group 4th to Joanne Johnston's Lakeland, **Arete's Big Bang Debut** (see photo on page 5). The last day a local judge, Yvonne Savard, didn't place any club members' dogs.

As you can see from the Terrier Specialty results, Cheryl Goodfellow scored a big upset win by going Best in Specialty, with her Irish, **Fairplay's Shameless Hearsay** (over the current #1 Terrier). Here's her account of the win: "I had an exciting weekend at the Renaissance shows (Terrier Breeders' Association of Canada Specialty) on [April 15th, 2018](#). A young homebred bitch (2-years old) of mine, Fairplay's Shameless Hearsay won the Group at the TBAC Specialty under judge Lynne Myall out of the Bred-By Class. This was quite a thrill for me because I handled "Pickles" all the way to the Group win. I was so shocked at winning the Group that I was left speechless – I wasn't expecting any Group placements on the weekend and knew that I wasn't facing any Irish Terrier competition so was just using the venue for training. At the same set of shows last year, Pickles won the Breed over competition at the Renaissance all-breed show and won a Group 2nd for a 5-point win. With the win last year and the win this year, she is now a new Canadian Champion! Thinking back, I now realize that this is the first Group 1st that I have ever won handling my own dogs – I have won Breed at an Irish Terrier Specialty in the US but never won a Group 4 Specialty as an owner/handler. Interestingly, one of my bitches, **Am/Can. Ch. Fairplay's Lola Pistola** (handled by Michelle Yeadon) won the first annual TBAC Specialty back in 2007 out of the Open Bitch Class at that Specialty."

IN MEMORIAM ROSE PARKER – LIFE MEMBER

Club members have been saddened to hear of the passing last year of one of our longest Life Members, Rose Parker, a pioneer in the Australian Terrier breed in Canada with her Yaralla Kennel. For the last several years, Rose lived in a long-term care facility in Courtenay, not far from the Glacier View show site. I visited her a few times there to deliver our newsletter, and once her hearing aid was in, we tried to communicate. I'm not really sure she recognized me, but when she looked at the photos of our club trophy winners in the newsletter, her face brightened and she exclaimed "oh, that's a good one". So, for a few moments I felt her old 'terrier spirit' was still there. At the entrance to her room, in a display case, I saw her wedding photo and two photos of her dogs, one with four head studies.



At the right is an ad from 1996. She also published a rather bittersweet retirement ad in the May 2004 issue of *Dogs in Canada*, and also in *Canine Review*. On the following page you can see it includes a photo of Rose's "beginning" with two German Shepherds (a breed she had in 1955) and an Australian, the breed she brought into Canada in 1962 (the year she founded the Alberni Valley K.C.) and championed ever since for over 40 years. The other photo is identified as "2003 - The End" and shows Rose with her famous "Mr. Blue". In between is a map of Canada and the U.S. showing the provinces and states (plus several countries in Europe and British Guyana) identifying, as the old song goes, "where have my little dogs gone". Indeed, her Yaralla line is famous worldwide among Aussie fanciers.

The comprehensive book on the breed, Pamela McDougall Douglas' *The Australian Terrier*, includes a section on Rose's Yaralla kennel and its many achievements, such as the first Canadian all-breed BIS Aussie under judge Elmer Grieve, several Best Puppy in Show, and her two imports chosen by Cam Milward, the Australian Fox Terrier breeder and judge, including Ch. Nayook Colonel Hathie who was top Aussie in 1971, 1972 and 1973. Another import in 1983 was Ch. Taralee Not Bad who sired many champions, including the spectacular Can/Am Ch. Yaralla's Rock The Ring who was Top Aussie in the U.S. in 1995-96 and placed Group 2nd at Westminster. Rose fondly recalled the lavish Pedigree Awards dinner in Louisville, KY, which celebrated those wins, as part of a 4-day show where Rocky took the Breed each day and placed Group 4th under terrier breeder judge Ruth Cooper.
