## IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO ALL BCATC MEMBERS

We the BCATC Executive, are once again seeking the input of all our members in determining where we go with our BCATC Specialty show or shows after our 2014 Specialty. As noted in the minutes of our August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Executive meeting, a decision was made based on the input received from you, our BCATC membership, to hold our 2014 Specialty show in conjunction with the Renaissance Show held in Chilliwack, BC on **Sunday April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014**. Our judge will be Terrier Breeder/Judge, Mrs. Chris Levy from Salem, Oregon.

In an effort to engage as many of our membership as possible to participate in our Specialty shows we are once again reaching out to you for your ideas. Some ideas that came forward from your initial responses with respect to our Specialty were:

1. Keep the Specialty show in one location having a large enough venue to accommodate agility, obedience and conformation. Close to amenities with adequate motel/hotel/restaurant facilities. Adequate RV parking with power. Adequate grooming space with power.
2. Holding roving Specialties on Vancouver Island and the Interior, alternating locations with the Lower Mainland. This option would provide an opportunity for all our membership to have easy access to our Specialty once every three years without extensive travel from Vancouver Island or the Interior, but traditionally these locations have not had large Terrier entries.
3. Holding a Specialty with a "Destination Theme" such as "Wine Country", including a winery, or wineries, tours and dinner.

Of note: I have been approached by the Kamloops & District Kennel Club to hold a Fall 2014 BCATC Specialty show in conjunction with their show on the Labour Day weekend 2014. I have also been approached by the Skaha Kennel Club to hold a Fall 2015 BCATC Specialty show in conjunction with their show in September 2015. Please provide your input with respect to these two noted requests as well.

Should our BCATC Specialty shows be held outside the Lower Mainland area, we will be seeking the assistance of our membership who live in the area in which a Specialty may be held to help organize, advertise, set up and run the "show"! Our goal is to ensure that as many of our BCATC membership as possible have an equal opportunity to participate in our Specialty shows as we can reasonably provide for.

We appreciate your membership, your input and your participation! Please provide your responses by **October 30, 2013**.

## MONTGOMERY COUNTY KC NEWS

---

Some exciting news from the Norman girls. Kerry, Kelly, Anita and Deena travelled to Blue Bell PA with their Import Bitch “Lexi” to one of the most exciting Terrier shows in the world, Montgomery County. At the preliminary shows (Hatboro, Devon) Lexi placed in the ribbons each day. On **Sunday, Ch. Saredon Shockwaves Of Irisblu** was awarded Best of Breed over an entry of 100 Kerry Blues! This show is considered the National show for the United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club.

Anita Norman co-owns Lexi with Harold Quigg of Ireland. Lexi is currently ranked #3 in all breed and breed points in the USA for Kerry Blues and #1 Kerry Blue in Canada, #3 Terrier.

There were over 40 Welsh Terrier entries at MCKC 2013 of which 4 during the weekend were bred and owned by Larisa Hotchin of Darwyn. The most exciting news is JAVA! Java – **Can GCh & Am Ch Darwyn’s Special Blend** was Winners Dog for a 4-point major at Devon the day before Montgomery County show, and AWARD OF MERIT at MCKC, which is the National Specialty for the Welsh Terrier Club of America! Devon is also a designated WTCA specialty, but Montgomery is the National Specialty!

The win at Devon finished Java’s American Championship, so we decided to move him up to the specials class for MCKC day. The judges for both Devon and MCKC are long time, and very successful, Welsh Terrier breeder judges. It was a true honor to be chosen by these men who likely have forgotten more about the breed than I (Larisa Hotchin) currently know. The other 2 days of the MCKC weekend, Java was 2<sup>nd</sup> in an extremely competitive Open class with dogs much more mature, and older, than he currently is (he is 18 months old).

Darwyn also had 2 Open Bitches shown on MCKC weekend (not one shown in Canada before). Tina, shown by Ernesto Lara, was 2<sup>nd</sup> in her class each day she was shown. Jessie, conditioned and shown by her co-owner Jane, was the only owner-handler in open and she was 3<sup>rd</sup> in her class of 5 the only day she was shown. Larisa conditioned and presented her young bitch “Maria” of 12 months and 1 week old in the 12-18 class. Larisa was the only owner-handler in the class and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the class, out of 5, each day Maria was shown. At MCKC, the National Specialty, Maria was awarded Best Opposite Sex in the sweepstakes out of 13. Larisa pulled Maria from competition for the regular classes so that she could actually watch the dogs properly at least once on the weekend!



Prior to MCKC weekend, Java was shown at the Michigan Terrier Specialty. He was Best of Winners and Best Opposite Sex at the Terrier Specialty on the first day (over 7 others), and repeated this again the next day under judge Mr. Clay Coody (who provided very positive feedback about his soundness and type and quality). We pulled him from competition the final day to ensure someone else could get points going into MCKC weekend (we have a very small breed and need to work together).

## MORE BCATC MEMBER NEWS

Allyn Power reports about her Lakelands, that on [April 6](#) in Red Deer, on their first time out as a brace, "DD" **Ch Threlfall Tantoo Cardinal JE** and her daughter "Purple" **Threlfall Diamond Tooth Gertie**, took Best Brace in Show. On a sadder note, [May 11](#) saw us bid goodbye to "Divot" **Can & Intl Ch Threlfall Tee Shot AgN NAC**, the other half of our first generation blue brace with daughter "DD".

At the PEAA den trials in September, Purple earned qualifying scores in all 4 tests, easily completing her JE title the first day, unlike her mother who took 3 years to earn hers. DD blew all 4 Senior tests by requiring a second command before doing perfect runs, including fantastic recalls which I never thought she'd do. The race is on now to see which one will get that SE title first. Big thanks to judges Chris Wheeldon and Lia Bijsterveld and to Dian Stafford-Gilmour for the great candid shots.

At Darwyn Welsh Terriers, 5 healthy puppies were born on Canada Day! They are now 16 weeks old and at this point we are growing up 4 as prospective show dogs. A breeder from Japan visited our home and brought a bitch to breed to our special dog "Joe" this past summer. This fall, his girl whelped 5 healthy puppies. In addition our dog in Germany, littermate to our specials dog "Java", has sired 2 beautiful litters which the respective breeders are very excited about and think very highly of. Earlier this year one of our specials dogs "Monty" sired a wonderful litter of 6 puppies for a breeder in Ontario – we believe the girl they kept will be shown during 2014, helping to keep our breed alive in Canada. We do not breed much, but we are very proud of the contribution to the breed that we do both in the show ring, advocate and public promoter for health testing as well as working with other quality "boutique" breeders.

Club life member Sheila Ehmann reports that "In April we (Lorne and I) purchased a puppy from Linda Carmichael of Windacre WHWT in Merritt, BC. Breeder/owner handled to 14 points (3 majors), she was sent out with Kate McMillan to find her final point, which she did at the Bonneville Basin K.C. show going Winners Bitch, Best of Winners, Best Opposite for 5 points under Judge Darryl Vice.



Heather Tomlins reports that in July we attended the Stumptown/Portland Cluster. Once again we had a nice turnout of 14 Norwich. At the Terrier Association of Oregon Show our young bitch **Amblegreen Zigzag Mystic Mojo** went Winners Bitch/BOS for a 5 point major. "Macy" is bred and co-owned by Heather Tomlins & Joan Herstein. Handled by Heather Tomlins. On the next day at the Portland show she went Winners Bitch again for a 4 point major and finished at 11 months. On the Sunday she went Select bitch. Our **Am. Ch. Amblegreen Tutti Frutti** (Tutti) went Select Bitch at the Terrier Association Show, Best Opposite the Saturday of Portland and took the Breed on the Sunday.

In August at the All Terrier Club of Western Washington/Sammamish KC shows our Tutti went Best of Breed all 3 days and finished her Grand Championship as well. Select Bitch traded back and forth between our young Macy and Tutti's litter Sister "Taffi" (**Am. Ch. Amblegreen Raffi Taffi** – co-owned with Lynne Davis).



Debbie Miyashita reports that two of her Border Terriers, **Borderhouse United Border** (Captain) and **Fernrigg's Romeo** (Beaver) finished their championships at the Skaha show, and Beaver (pictured below) took Best Puppy in Group one day. **Fernrigg's Foxtrot** (Piper) got her first points and fist major at this show AND took best puppy in Group one day.



## SHOW WINS

At the Pacific K.C. shows July 25-28, Rick Fehler, Judy McVeigh, Karen Doyle, and Raymond Lariviere judged about 25-30 terriers. Consistent winners were Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**, who went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Fehler, Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under McVeigh & Doyle, and Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**, who won the group under Lariviere, Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Fehler, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under McVeigh. Also Ken & Elaine Allen's Min. Schnauzer **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** also went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Doyle. The Welsh puppy, **Darwyn's Santa Maria**, took Puppy Group under Lariviere and went on to BPIS under terrier breeder and former club member Doyle.

At the six Prince George KC shows that same weekend, the Welsh **Darwyn You Make My Heart Sing** won the small terrier group (and went RBIS) under veteran judge Don Fitzsimmons, Jacqueline Rusby, and Tom Alexander, and went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Ole Nielsen and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Mary White. Florence Yunik's new Sealyham, **Bushwell Makers Mark**, went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Rusby, and Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Deborah Graffmann.

On the Vancouver Island circuit, Aug. 3 -11, starting with Campbell River Dog Fanciers, Ken & Elaine Allen's **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Garry Allen; then Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Pamela Bruce and Mary White at Glacier View; Jackie Marriott's Scottie, **Ch. Glenby's Midnight Journey**, went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Grant Townsend, and Group 4<sup>th</sup> under White. At Victoria City, Margaret Jones' Cairn, **Kian's Solar Light**, went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Joy McFarlane, with the Scottie going Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**, went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Ainslie Mills and Janet Lobb.

The West Kootenay shows in Castlegar Aug 16-18 had a much larger terrier entry (22) than last year. **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Honey Glendinning, Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Lynda Saranchuk, and Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Mel Saranchuk. Kelly Greir's Westie, **Ch. Mysticgold's Power Play**, went Group 4<sup>th</sup> under Harold Pybus.

Kamloops & Dist. K.C. held a 4-day show this year, Aug. 20-Sept. 2, but with a lower terrier entry (16). **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** went Group 2<sup>nd</sup> under Jim Reynolds, Group 4<sup>th</sup> under David Ojalvo, and Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Enrique Filippini. The same judges gave Best Puppy in Group to the Welsh, **Darwyn's Santa Maria**.

The following weekend at Skaha K.C., also with a smaller entry than previous years, **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer** went Group 3<sup>rd</sup> under Yvonne Savard, Linda Kraft and Ainslie Mills. Puppy Group winners included the Border Terriers, **Fernrigg's Romeo** and **Fernrigg's Foxtrot** under Kraft and Mills.

At the Mt. Cheam K.C. shows in Chilliwack, Sept. 20-22, the Westie (currently #1 dog in the country) was absent, and so three different dogs won the terrier group. Anita Norman's Kerry, **Ch. Saredon Shockwaves At Irisblu**, won the group the first day under Lucie Paradis, with John & Penny Rogers' Wheaten, **Ch. Cashel's Oban On Ice**, going Group 3<sup>rd</sup>. The second day Andy Hsieh placed Min. Schnauzer, **Ch. Dreamaker High Flyer**, Group 2<sup>nd</sup>, followed by the Kerry in 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The last day, Peter Machen placed the Wheaten Group 2<sup>nd</sup>, and the Kerry Group 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The Fraser Valley Dog Fanciers shows were held in Cloverdale Oct. 11-14. Club member Karsten Kaemling chose Larisa Hotchin's Welsh, **GCh. Darwyn's Special Blend**, group 2<sup>nd</sup>, with the Kerry, **Ch. Saredon Shockwaves At Irisblu**, as Group 3<sup>rd</sup>, with Best Puppy going to Ken & Elaine Allen's **Dreamaker Spitfire**. The second day, Stephen Hubbell reversed the Kerry and the Welsh, with the same puppy getting the nod. The third day, Peggy Gutierrez Otero placed the Welsh 4<sup>th</sup>, and gave puppy group to Jackie Marriot's Scottie, **Dunsmuir's Midnight Sorcerer**. The last day, club member Bruce Fraser gave Group 4<sup>th</sup> to Florence Yunik's Sealyham, **Bushwell Makers Mark**, and best puppy to the Scottie.

**News from Darwyn Welsh Terriers:** After 2 very serious campaign years with Joe being at the forefront of the Darwyn team and ending up a Top 10 dog amongst all breeds in Canada for both 2011 and 2012 ... 2013 has been a year that we have focussed on finishing a few dogs that have been waiting in the wings.

Our Hungarian imported bitch, Noodles, (who looks absolutely dyed since her color is pure mahogany – she goes back to dogs in the late '70s in the breed) finished her championship in early August with Judge Jon Cole giving her WB over our Montgomery WB girl Dora, now **Ch. Matranensis Nitro Noodle**. She is part way to her Am. Ch., so we just need to find her some points and get her back into show condition!

Ella (**Ch. Darwyn You Make My Heart Sing**) finished with multiple Group 1<sup>st</sup> and a Reserve Best in Show at the Prince George shows. She now has a family of her own, including a 3 year old child who adores her, and she will hopefully contribute future Darwyn Champions one day.

Dora finally came out to the Canadian show rings after having 2 wonderful litters (she is already the dam of multiple group winners and she herself finished her American Championship with WB at the WTCA national at Montgomery 2011). Dora finished her Canadian Championship by defeating 2 Canadian Specials and multiple group placements at the show in Manitoba that hosts their Red River Terrier Specialty. Dora now lives on Protection Island waiting to have another litter one day.

Maria (**Ch. Darwyn's Santa Maria**) finished her Canadian Ch. with BOB over specials, Group 2<sup>nd</sup>, multiple BPIS and multiple BPIG wins, including the Purina National held in conjunction with the AKC in August.

Java (**Can GCh. & Am Ch. Darwyn's Special Blend**) finished his championship earlier this year with group placements and BPIS wins and finished his Grand Championship this summer. **Java is Canada's first Welsh Terrier Grand Champion!**

**Foreign Show News from Darwyn:** MJ (Multi Int. Ch. Darwyn's Mighty Joe Young – Java's brother) was shown 8 times and each time was awarded the rating Excellent V1 (and wonderful written critiques!). He was awarded a number of titles, but the ones that stood out were the German and Switzerland Championships. Zorro (Can & Brazil Ch. Darwyn Don Diego de la Vega) is shown by handler Claudio in Brazil. He has won multiple Groups and BIS2, BIS3 and BIS4 ratings multiple times. Zorro is Ella's brother and another Dora son (half-brother to Java, the young special we are currently showing).

Dr. Tracey Griffin, DVM, will offer her suggestions on how to reduce the risk of performance injuries in working and performance dogs.

Dogs will do almost anything we ask of them. The question is: Do we want them doing things that they are structurally incapable of doing without breaking down? Is that what we really want from our most steadfast companions? The more we can learn about canine structure, the more we understand what it is reasonable to ask of our dogs, given their physical strengths and weaknesses.
