Marauders Hey Jude**) at coming up to 9 years old was Best in Regional Specialty under Lois Wilson.

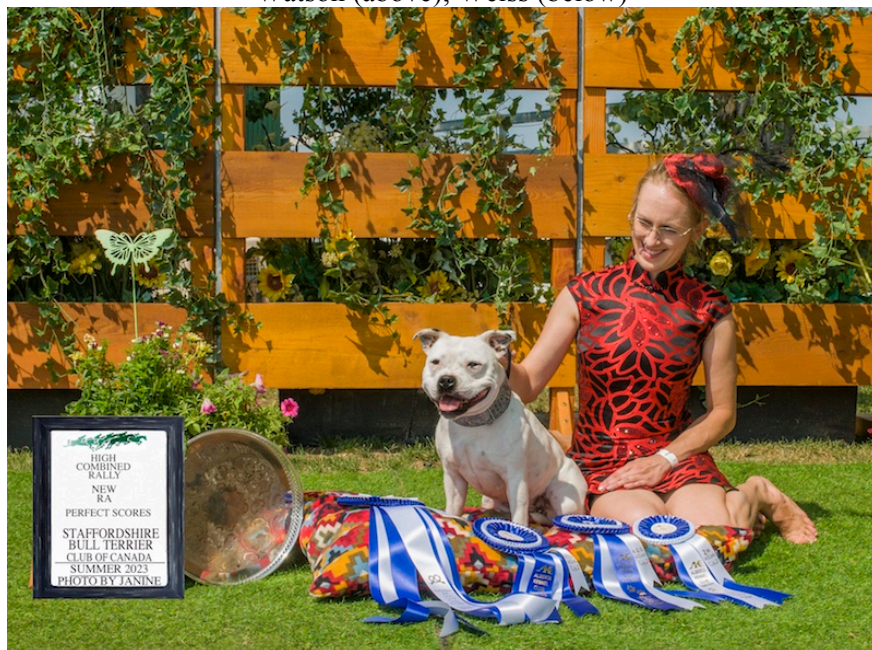
